them discuss the Trilby murder with you after that time? 2 3 Α No. And to the best of your recollection that 5 discussion at Cash Quarters took place on the morning right after the homicide was committed? 6 7 Α Yes, sir. After the killing. Did you know either of 8 Q 9 the two boys that were killed? Α No. 10 Do you know what the killing was about, why? 11Q No. 12 Α Did Luke discuss why he killed them? 13 0 I quess because they wouldn't cooperate. 14 That's all I can think of. 15 16 They wouldn't cooperate? O. Α I guess. 17|Wouldn't cooperate for what purpose? 18 I don't know. The only thing I know about Α 19 them boys is that they knew some boy that Luke and 20 21 Jeremy was trying to talk to, I guess, resolve a problem; and they wouldn't tell. I guess they 22 wouldn't tell Luke and Jeremy where he stayed. 23 Now, this happened way before they even got 24 25 killed or whatever.

Q Was it over a drug deal? I do not know. 2 Α Do you think it was? 3 Q I do not know. 4 Α What did Jeremy tell you about these boys 5 not giving the name up of somebody that they wanted? 6 He wasn't worried about it. Α 8 Q. What? He wasn't worried about it. 9 Α But he told you about it. Q 10 Yep. 11 A What did Jeremy tell you? 12 Q He didn't tell me nothing. And then Luke, Andre and Darnell, they all came, and Tyree, they all came another time, and that time I know about is when they came to Commie's house and supposedly they gave Jeremy a gun to sell.

Q They gave Jeremy a gun? That was the third visit?

A Like the second or third, something like that.

Q And who was there that time, Luke, Andre, Darnell and Tyree?

A Yes. Me, Jeremy, Commie and I think Ashley was there.

- Q That was Commie's girlfriend?
- A Um-hum.
 - Q And they gave Jeremy a gun?
- A Supposedly they gave him a gun.
- Q What for?
 - A He was supposed to be selling to get rid of.
- Q Get rid of the gun?
- 23 A Um-hum. Yes.
 - Q Was this the gun that you understood to be used in the Trilby murders?

I was guessing so. 1 Α That's what you concluded from it? 2 Q Yes, sir. Α Did you see the gun? 4 Q 5 Α No. Did Jeremy tell you what it looked like? 6 Q Nope. 7 A Did Jeremy tell you what he did with it? 8 Q Sold it to somebody. 9 Α Sold it? 10 Q 11 Um-hum. Α To who? 12 Q I don't know. 13 Α Is this what Jeremy told you? 14 Q 15 Α Yes. When did you first meet Commie Pattmon? 16 Q Oh --17 Α Let's talk about it in relation to Jeremy's 18 Q death, which was August 13th, I believe, of 2006. 19 long before that did you know Commie? 20 I'd say about five or six months. 21 And for some period of time you started 22 O. living with he and his girlfriend, correct? 23 I wouldn't call it living, but I guess so. 24 Α Staying, staying over visiting maybe? 25 Q

No. Α Did Jeremy Henry ever tell you that Commie 8 0 Pattmon was involved in the Trilby murders? 9 No. Α 10 Did Jeremy ever tell you that he told Commie 11 Pattmon about the Trilby murders? 12 13 Α No. Did Jeremy Henry express any fear to you 14 from Luke or Andre? 15 16l А No. Or Tyree or Darnell? 17 Q No. 18 Α Did he ever express any fear of Commie to 19 20 you? 21 Α No. Did you understand he and Commie were 22 Q friends? 23 Yes. 24 A 25 You know now that Commie Pattmon has been Q

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charged with Jeremy's killing. 1 2 Α Yes. What do you know about that? O. I don't know nothing about it. Α Nobody told you about what happened? 5 Q About? What are you talking about? Α About whether Commie killed him or not? 0 Oh, as far as I know, I don't know. 8 Α really don't know. I'm not going to tell you about 9 10 that. 11 Since the murder, have you had any discussions with Commie Pattmon about what happened, 12 whether he was involved in the murder of Jeremy Henry? 13 You mean -- do you mean between the time 14 Α 15 that Jeremy got killed or since he been in jail? Q Either one. 16 I talked to him the morning it happened. 17 Α To Commie? 18 0 Yes, sir. 19 A 20 Q And what did he tell you? He wouldn't tell me nothing. 21 A He didn't say anything? 22 Q Nope. He left. A 23 Was that the night he and Jeremy went off to 24 Q Dade City? 25

- A Um-hum. Yes, sir.
- Q And then they came back, or rather Commie came back, and you asked him about where Jeremy was.
 - A Yes.

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- Q And what did he tell you?
- A He didn't know.
- Q He didn't give you any statement about what happened?

A All he said was -- well, rather I woke up and he was there. And I asked him where Jeremy was, and he said he didn't know.

Then I asked him again, and he was just like, "Oh, we went to Dade City. We got high, and he left with someone with dreads. He left walking down the road."

- Q What did he say then about it?

A He left about an hour or so and he came back, and I kept calling him because I wanted to know. And I asked him again what happened.

He said, "Jeremy left with a boy with some dreads, left walking down the road."

I said, "First of all, I know Jeremy. And if he was high, he wouldn't have left walking. He would have made you get out of your vehicle, and you would have left walking because I know him."

He was just like, "I don't know what happened. He was calling me this and calling me that and he left walking."

Q Did Commie indicate to you that there was some kind of an argument between them?

A Yes, sir.

Q Do you know whether Jeremy Henry had a gun that evening or that morning?

A No, I don't.

- Q Did he usually carry a gun?
- A Sometimes.

What kind of gun? Q A I don't know. You've seen it though? Q Yes. Α Is it like an automatic, semiautomatic or is 5 Q it like a pistol? 6 He had different ones. Can't tell? You don't know the difference? 8 Q I know the difference, but he had different 9 Α 10 ones. He had different ones. Did he keep some 11 0 guns or ammunition in Commie Pattmon's trunk? 12 A No. 13 Do you know of an area in Chesterfield Road 14 Q 15 that Jeremy stayed sometimes?
