

## **WHO is JESUS?**

**“How do you know there is a Heaven or Hell? How can you be sure about it?” you asked inquisitively.**

**“The Bible says so,” I stated back.**

**“Here we go again—the Bible talk. If the Bible is fiction, someone made it up, and then there’s no Heaven or Hell, nor GOD. Nobody has seen GOD, and ‘The Bible says so’ is your only response.” You sneer.**

**“Of course, we met GOD 2,000 years ago. HIS name is JESUS.” I said.**

**When I named JESUS, you began laughing, which profoundly irritated me, but I wanted to continue.**

**“I knew you would bring up JESUS. I knew it. Tell me about JESUS. Who is HE? And why do you depend on HIM so much? Make me believe that JESUS is GOD!” you demanded.**

**I looked at you with a big grin as if I had half-expected it.**

**“You want to know about JESUS?” I saw a yearning in your eyes.**

**Suddenly, my heart was filled with pity for you. A long time ago, I didn’t believe in JESUS either.**

**“Before I talk to you about JESUS, I want you to know that what I tell you is not my theory or fiction but the Bible that I’ll be quoting.**

**GOD wrote the Bible through HIS anointed people.**

**GOD breathed in the Bible.**

**GOD has spoken in the Bible.**

**Finally, GOD Himself came to earth and gave HIS message to the people 2,000 years ago.**

**One of the most significant witnesses of JESUS was the Apostle Paul.**

**He formerly persecuted those who believed in JESUS:**

***‘ Meanwhile, Saul was still breathing out murderous threats against the LORD’s disciples. He went to the high priest and asked him for letters to the synagogues in Damascus, so that if he found any there who belonged to the Way, whether men or women, he might take them as prisoners to Jerusalem. As he neared Damascus on his journey, suddenly a light from Heaven flashed around him. He fell to the ground and heard a voice say to him, “Saul, Saul, why do you persecute ME?” “Who are you, LORD?” Saul asked.***

***“I AM JESUS, whom you are persecuting,” HE replied. “Now get up and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do.” The men traveling with Saul stood there speechless; they heard the sound but did not see anyone. Saul got up from the ground, but when he opened his eyes he could***

*see nothing. So they led him by the hand into Damascus. For three days, he was blind and did not eat or drink anything.*

*In Damascus there was a disciple named Ananias. The LORD called to him in a vision, "Ananias!"*

*"Yes, LORD," he answered.*

*The LORD told him, "Go to the house of Judas on Straight Street and ask for a man from Tarsus named Saul, for he is praying. In a vision, he has seen a man named Ananias come and place his hand on him to restore his sight."*

*"LORD," Ananias answered, "I have heard many reports about this man and all the harm he has done to YOUR Holy people in Jerusalem. And he has come here with authority from the chief priests to arrest all who call on YOUR Name."*

*But the LORD said to Ananias, "Go! This man is MY chosen instrument to proclaim MY name to the Gentiles and their kings and the people of Israel. I will show him how much he must suffer for MY Name."*

*Then Ananias went to the house and entered it. Placing his hands on Saul, he said, "Brother Saul, the LORD JESUS, who appeared to you on the road as you were coming here- has sent me so that you may see again and be filled with the HOLY SPIRIT." Immediately, something like scales fell from Saul's eyes, and he could see again. He got up and was baptized, and after taking some food, he regained his strength. Saul spent several days with the disciples in Damascus. At once he began to preach in the synagogues that JESUS is the SON of GOD. All those who heard him were astonished and asked, "Isn't he the man who raised havoc in Jerusalem among those who call on this name? And hasn't he come here to take them as prisoners to the chief priests? Yet Saul grew more and more powerful and baffled the Jews living in Damascus by proving that JESUS is the Messiah." (Acts 9: 1-22)*

**This remarkable tale is about Paul's transformation from persecutor of Christians to one of their foremost Christian leaders.**

**As JESUS instructed, he boldly proclaimed JESUS's name to the Gentiles, their kings, and the people of Israel.**

**He believed in JESUS without seeing or touching HIM.**

**He demonstrated his steadfast faith in the world through his unshakable belief in JESUS.**

**Other witnesses to JESUS were the disciples, who met JESUS in person, spread JESUS' name, and healed the sick in the name of the HOLY SPIRIT.**

**All the witnesses are in the Bible, in which they wrote the true story of JESUS, the SON of GOD.**

**The most powerful witness is JESUS's disciple Simon Peter, who was with JESUS until HIS resurrection. And Peter died for the name of JESUS.**

**He wrote this in the Bible:**

**'For we did not follow cleverly devised stories when we told you about the coming of our LORD JESUS CHRIST in power, but we were eyewitnesses to HIS majesty. HE received honor and glory from GOD the FATHER when the voice came to HIM from the Majestic Glory, saying, "This is MY SON, whom I love; with HIM I AM well pleased." We ourselves heard this voice that came from heaven when we were with HIM on the sacred mountain. We also have the prophetic message as something completely reliable, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your heart.'**

**(2 Peter 1: 16-19)**

**Whoever wrote the New Testament had different backgrounds; nonetheless, they all came to the same conclusion: JESUS is the SON of GOD.**

**JESUS said: 'I and the FATHER are ONE.' (John 10:30)**

**JESUS is GOD. GOD is JESUS. They are ONE and must not be separated. Whoever can't believe that JESUS is GOD has no GOD in his heart; it is impossible to believe in GOD and reject JESUS."**

**"Why did HE have to come down to earth? Couldn't HE have managed from Heaven?" you asked.**

**'For GOD so loved the world that HE gave His only Son that whoever believes in HIM shall not perish but have eternal life.' (John 3:16)**

**"GOD bestowed on us the Ten Commandments, the law, and the regulations through Moses, but we failed to follow HIS divine law and instructions. As a result, the earth is full of malice, wickedness, depravity, and evil. It is profoundly immoral and idolatrous.**

**Therefore, GOD's amazing love and grace wanted to be face-to-face with us to deliver HIS message of saving our failing souls, and JESUS wants us to go to heaven with HIM.**

**HE had to come from Heaven in a human, and HIS earthly name was JESUS.**

**During HIS visit to the earth, HE created the New Testament, the fresh breath of GOD's Words.**

**JESUS's purpose in coming to the world was to be GOD's messenger for the lost, to rescue them.**

**JESUS said:**

**'Repent for the kingdom of Heaven is at hand.' (Matthew 4:17)**

**'I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.'**

**(Luke 5:32)**

**'Very truly, I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of GOD unless they are born of water and spirit.' (John 3:5)**

**'I AM the light of the world. Whoever follows ME will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.' (John 8:12)**

**'I AM the living bread that came down from Heaven. Whoever eats this will live forever. This bread is MY flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.' (John 6:51)**

**'Remain in ME, as I also in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in ME.**

**I AM the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in ME and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from ME you can do nothing.'(John 15:4-5)**

**JESUS is the mediator of a New Covenant, so JESUS was sacrificed once to take away the sins of the many. HE ministered before our eyes: lived, ate, and wept with us. Before, HE was an untouchable heavenly FATHER, but HE came down to join us as our earthly FATHER, a very tangible FATHER, HE wanted to have a personal relationship with us, not as the Creator, but as the Father of our family. ## **JESUS's Love**

**"I've heard so many people say that 'JESUS loves you!' To me, it's just empty words that sound unrealistic. I never feel HIS love or existence."**

**You were a little agitated.**

**"Have you ever loved someone before? I mean true love," I asked.**

**“I did, but she never loved me back. It was an unrequited love,” you confessed.**

**“So you loved her, but she didn’t love you back, right?” I asked.**

**“Yes,” you said.**

**“This is a good example of how to explain JESUS’s love. You were truly in love with your friend, but she didn’t love you. Therefore, she didn’t feel your love for her.**

**Do you understand?” I asked.**

**“Yes, I understand.”**

**“If you don’t feel JESUS’s love, then you don’t love HIM. It’s unrequited love. JESUS loves you, but you don’t love HIM; that’s why you couldn’t feel HIS love, and it becomes hard to believe in HIS existence and HIS love, but JESUS loves you in spite of your unrequited love for HIM.” I concluded.**

**“How come you are so confident that JESUS is GOD?” you asked.**

**“The HOLY SPIRIT proved it to me,” I said.**

**“HOLY SPIRIT?” You asked.**

**“Yes, HOLY SPIRIT. JESUS gave us a gift: the HOLY SPIRIT.**

**Since I accepted JESUS CHRIST as my Savior, He has dwelt inside of me.**

**I believe GOD, the SON, and the HOLY SPIRIT, the Three in One, are living in me.**

**When I am talking to you, it isn’t me talking; the HOLY SPIRIT is.”**

**John the Baptist recognized JESUS as GOD.**

**‘The next day John saw JESUS coming toward him and said, Look, the Lamb of GOD Who takes away the sin of the world!’ (John 1:29)**

**‘I have seen and I testify that this is GOD’s Chosen ONE.’ (John 1:34)**

**‘After me comes the One more powerful than I, the straps of whole sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. I baptize with water, but HE will baptize you with the HOLY SPIRIT.’ (Mark 1: 7 -8)**

**‘Simon Peter answered, “YOU are the CHRIST, the Son of the living GOD.”’ (Matthew 16:16)**

**‘As soon as JESUS was baptized, HE went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and HE saw the Spirit of GOD descending**

like a dove and alighting on HIM. And a voice from heaven said, "This is MY SON, whom I love; with HIM I AM well pleased."  
(Matthew 3: 16-17)

Even the demons believed JESUS is the Son of GOD:

'Whenever the impure spirits saw HIM, they would fell down before HIM and cried out, "You are the SON of GOD.'" (Mark 3:11)

'In the synagogue, there was a man possessed by a demon, an impure spirit. He cried out top of his voice, "Go away! What do want with us, JESUS of Nazareth? Have YOU come to destroy us? I know who YOU are- the HOLY ONE of GOD!'" (Luke 4:33-34)

'You believe that there is one GOD. Even the demons believe that- and shudder.'  
(James 2:19)

'Whenever the unclean spirits saw HIM, they would fell down before HIM and cried out, "YOU are the SON of GOD!'" (Mark 3:11)

'When he saw JESUS from a distance, he ran and fell on his knees in front of HIM. He shouted at the top of his voice, "What do you want with me, JESUS, SON of the Most High GOD? In GOD's name don't torture me!'"  
(Mark 5:6-8)

The demon declared JESUS to be the Son of Most High GOD.

**Therefore, are you not better than demons?"**

"Why did HE choose to be a carpenter?" Your questions were getting more intimidating. I felt a great struggle.

"Because HE is a humble GOD. HE could have become anyone HE wanted to be.

HE could've wanted to be the king of Israel, a highly regarded clerical figure, or even the wealthiest man in Israel, which would have given HIM a better position to induce the people to turn to HIM since humans are prone to follow power, wealth, and high status. So why did HE have to come in human flesh and be born in a stable where the animals live? He

**chooses unschooled, ordinary fishermen to be HIS disciples. Furthermore, HE even washed HIS disciples' feet with water. GOD is a humble GOD.**

**'GOD detests all the proud heart.' (Proverbs 16:5)**

**HE chose a murderer who became a shepherd, Moses, to save Israel from Egypt.**

**HE chose the smallest country on earth as the foundation for HIS Gospel.**

**HE chose the most stubborn people in the world to be HIS chosen people.**

**HE chose the smallest town on earth for JESUS to be born in.**

**HE chose the lowest status on earth, the fisherman, to lead the gospel.**

**HE chose the most sinful humans on earth, us, to be HIS children.**

**HE chose Paul, the persecuted Christian, to spread the Gospel to the world.**

**HE chose poor instead of rich.**

**HE chose sick instead of healthy.**

**HE chose children instead of adults.**

**Beauty, wealth, and high status are not what GOD seeks. HE is looking for the humble heart that believes JESUS is the Savior of the world. That's what GOD is looking for and wants them to be on HIS side when we go to Heaven.**

**JESUS said: 'I come to serve, not be served'. GOD is a humble GOD.**

**Indeed.**

**"I love that JESUS chose to be a carpenter. The carpenter repairs broken things. And HE repairs our brokenness. HE sanded down our rough spot and polished it for the final work. What could be more suitable for HIM than that? HE reveals and demonstrates HIMSELF to us as willing and able to be humble. But in human prejudice and proud minds, they would not worship and follow a carpenter as their Savior, as those who are humble will. In HIS measurement, HE wants to know who the truly humble person is. HE is looking for a person with a humble heart who can accept HIM as HE is and as HE claims to be. When you accept JESUS as your SAVIOR, everything falls into place. Then, you can accept HIS teaching, healing, miracles, and, more importantly, the belief that JESUS is our GOD. If anyone has doubts about JESUS, they doubt GOD as well." I said.**

**“Why did HE have to die on the Cross if HE was an innocent man?” you protested.**

**JESUS said: ‘I AM the good shepherd; I know MY sheep and MY sheep know ME, just as the FATHER knows ME and I know the FATHER, and I lay down MY life for the sheep.’ (John 10: 14-15)**

**“JESUS was a pure, sinless, harmless, flawless man who lived a perfect life on earth. No human could accomplish what HE did.**

**Because HE is GOD.**

**The ordinary man would not give up his life for someone else’s sins.**

**If JESUS, an ordinary man, was just about to die on the cross because of his false claim, he would reverse his claim and save his life for himself, just like any human does when they are about to lose their life. But Jesus took the cross instead of walking away as a free man. Why? Because HE was the truth and the truth that HE couldn’t deny was carried onto the cross.**

**JESUS is the only sinless man who has lived on earth. As humans, there are no sinless people on earth, but only JESUS, and HE died for us so that we can be saved and have eternal life.”**

**Here is a list I offer you, and you can tell me whether HE deserved to die on the Cross.**

**HE was accused of telling the truth about the Kingdom of GOD;**

**HE was spat on for raising people from death;**

**HE was slandered for feeding the hungry;**

**HE was beaten for healing the blind, the paralyzed, lepers, and the demon- possessed;**

**HE was flogged for loving sinners;**

**HE was insulted for demonstrating how the people should love one another;**

**HE was mocked by being associated with sinners, tax collectors, adulteresses, prostitutes, and the outcasts that nobody wanted to be associated with. But JESUS did because JESUS is Love**

***‘You have heard that it was said, ‘Eye for an eye and tooth for a tooth’ But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to them the other cheek also. And if anyone wants to sue you and take your shirt, hand over your coat as well. If anyone forces you to go one mile,***

***go with them two miles. Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you.’ (Matthew 5:38-42)***

***‘Love your neighbor and hate your enemy, but I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be children of your FATHER in Heaven. HE causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? And if you greet only your own people, what are you doing more than others? Do not even pagans do that? Be perfect, therefore, as your Heavenly FATHER is perfect.’ (Matthew 5:43-48)***

***‘Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.’ (Luke 6:27-28)***

***‘If your enemy is hungry, feed them; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink.’ (Romans 12:20)***

***‘Come to ME, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take MY yoke upon you and learn from ME, for I AM gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For MY yoke is easy and MY burden is light.’ (Matthew 11: 28-30)***

***‘Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn’t he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, ‘Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.’ (Luke 15:4-6)***

***‘Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother's eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye? How can you say to your brother, ‘Brother, let me take the speck out of your eyes, when you yourself fail to see the plank in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother’s eye.’(Luke 6:41- 42)***

***‘JESUS said, It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick, but go and learn what this means: “I desire mercy, not sacrifice. For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners.”’ (Matthew 9:12-13)***

*‘The teachers of the law and the Pharisees brought in a woman caught in adultery. They made her stand before the group and said to JESUS, “Teacher, this woman was caught in the act of adultery. The Law of Moses commanded us to stone such women. Now, what do YOU say? They were using this question as a trap, in order to have a basis for accusing HIM. But, JESUS answered, “Let any of you without sin be the first to throw a stone at her.” At this, those who heard began to go away one at a time, the older ones first, until only JESUS was left, with the woman still standing there. “Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?” “No one, sir?” she said. “Then neither do I condemn you,” JESUS declared. “Go now and leave your life of sin.”’ (John 8: 3-11)*

The only one left standing was JESUS, the only Sinless MAN; HE was the only ONE Who could throw stones at her. But HE didn't. HE forgave her sin.

Because:

JESUS is Love.

JESUS is a peacemaker.

JESUS has unending love for us

JESUS showed and demonstrated to us love for one another

Jesus delivers us, love in perfection.

**When we follow HIS teaching, there will be no war nor sorrow on this earth but peace, hope, and love.”**

JESUS even loved those Pharisees, Sadducees, priests, teachers of law, high-ranking authorities, and the corrupted religious groups whose hearts were hardened to the truth. Though the people went through the proper rituals that GOD had commanded, their hearts were not with them. Therefore, it was the sin of the people that kept them from accepting JESUS as the Messiah.

HE repeatedly warned them of their iniquities and asked them to repent their sins and be saved, but they wanted to put HIM on the Cross.

*‘Watch out for the teachers of the law. They like to walk around in flowing robes and be greeted with respect in the marketplaces, and have the most important seats in the synagogues and the places of honor at banquets.*

***They devour widows' houses and for a show, make lengthy prayers. These men will be punished most severely.' (Mark 12: 38-40)***

***'It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of GOD.' (Matthew 19:24)***

***'Woe to you experts in the law, because you have taken away the key to knowledge. You yourselves have not entered, and you have hindered those who were entering.' (Luke 11:52)***

***'For I tell you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven.' (Matthew 5:20)***

**JESUS fearlessly warned those rich in power, wealth, and high status, those filled with great pride in their heart. JESUS constantly rebuked them for their self-righteousness and arrogance. HE reminded them of their hypocrisy.**

**They were corrupted in many different ways.**

**JESUS wanted to save them, so HE demanded that they repent of their sins.**

**In the past, no one challenged or rebuked them as JESUS had. This lowly carpenter who said HE was the Messiah had shaken their previously solid foundation.**

**HIS truthful words condemned them. Jesus had challenged and jeopardized their authority. And they wanted to kill HIM.**

**They wanted their MESSIAH to be superior to them, coming to them like a victorious warrior with a golden crown on HIS head. But JESUS was the opposite of their fantasy. Their hearts were full of pride, and they couldn't recognize JESUS as their Savior. Their sins blinded them.**

**Ultimately, they crucified HIM on the Cross.**

**Even though they put JESUS on the Cross, HE still loved them. HE could destroy them in HIS mighty power, but HE took the Cross instead of punishing them.**

**JESUS has spoken the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth. That ultimately put HIM on the Cross—the most innocent MAN died cruelly on the Cross.**

**HE is the only One who went through all the afflictions without sins because:**

**HE is GOD.**

*'Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by GOD, stricken by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wound we are healed. We all like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.'* (Isaiah 53:4-6)

The prophet Isaiah predicted in the Old Testament that JESUS would die for our sins.

In the Old Testament, GOD temporarily required animal sacrifices to cover sins. The animal had to be blameless, just like JESUS. Animal sacrifices have ended because JESUS CHRIST was the ultimate and perfect sacrifice. HE died for us. HIS innocent blood took away all of our iniquities, and HE shed blood on the Cross to wash away our sins.

'Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.' (Hebrews 9:22)  
JESUS' last words were, "It is finished." HE finished HIS job on the Cross.

JESUS came down to earth and built a bridge between Heaven and Earth, with the wooden cross and the three nails. Therefore, when you repent of your sins and receive JESUS as your SAVIOR, you will be in the bosom of the FATHER forever.

Do you want to know what GOD looks like? Look at JESUS.

HE is our GOD who chose to sit on the donkey instead of the king's chariot.

He is a humble GOD." I said solemnly.

## **Learning from Mosquitos.**

"Did you know how many people were killed by a little mosquito?" I asked.

Mosquitos cause at least 2.7 million deaths every year, and about 500 million cases of mosquito-borne diseases occur annually. This little insect taught us a good lesson about human vulnerability and weaknesses.

**'For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.' (Matthew 23:12)**

**'Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be your slave-just as the SON of MAN did not come to serve, but to serve, and to give HIS life as a ransom for many.' (Matthew 20: 26-28)**

**'Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.' (Matthew 7:13-14)**

**Humbleness is powerful, and it comes from GOD. When we choose to surrender every part of our lives to GOD, we will be rewarded.**

**I understand why people don't want to believe in JESUS: they simply don't want to believe. It is not that they could not believe, it is that they would not believe. All the Jews are authors of the New Testament, but it is not that people need more evidence; it is that they do not act upon the evidence that they have.**

**If they deny GOD, there is no Hell to be concerned about. But hell is not your option; it is GOD's Purpose, not your choice, but GOD's decision.**

**'The light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed.' (John 3:19-20)**

**'Surely the arm of the LORD is not too short to save, nor HIS ear too dull to hear. But your iniquities have separated you from your GOD; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.' (Isaiah 59:1-2)**

**GOD gave us free will. And when you choose a wide road with no rules and no regulations, you can ignore God's word that you can live as you want to, but there are consequences. If you choose darkness instead of light, and as a result become blind and deaf, and you can't see JESUS or**

hear HIS voice when HE is calling for you, eventually you will fall into the pits.

You closed the door on HIM while HE was knocking on it, wanting to come in.

You have two choices: are you willing to open the door for JESUS or not?

If you can't trust the person who died for you, who else can you trust?

Pride is the greatest enemy to accepting JESUS as your SAVIOR.

Pride always puts you first, and JESUS is last.
