Subject: Notice of Price Adjustment Due to Rising Energy Costs

Dear Valued Customer,

We are writing to inform you of an upcoming adjustment to the TreeHouse Foods pricing structure, driven by significant increases in global energy costs. As you are aware, the ongoing conflict in the Middle East has disrupted international energy markets, resulting in substantial increases in fuel, electricity, and transportation expenses.

For the food manufacturing sector, these energy-related cost pressures have an especially direct impact. Core areas of our operations—including ingredient processing, cooking and thermal treatments, refrigeration, sanitation cycles, packaging, and outbound logistics—are all highly energy-dependent. Over the past several weeks, the cost of powering and transporting our products has risen well beyond normal volatility.

We have taken extensive steps to absorb these increases through operational efficiencies, equipment optimization, and supply-chain hedge adjustments when possible. However, the scale and persistence of current market conditions now require us to implement a price adjustment.

Effective May 25, 2026, your prices will increase. The TreeHouse Commercial Team representative(s) you work with will provide you with new price lists and address any questions you may have.

This adjustment ensures we can continue meeting regulatory standards, maintaining consistent production schedules, and delivering the level of product integrity you expect and deserve.
