

The bulk of the series will shoot in New Mexico, which offers up to 35% back on eligible costs through one of the nation's most competitive film rebate programs. With its skilled crew base and diverse landscapes, it's ideal for both practical and VFX-heavy shoots.

CHRIS WALKER

Chris is a weathered construction worker whose rough exterior mirrors years of physical labor and mental strain. A heavy drinker influenced by his hard-living co-workers, he's grounded in realism, jaded by life's disappointments, and resigned to a fate far from his youthful ambitions. Once a promising UFC fighter, Chris was forced to abandon those dreams, the cage now a distant memory that haunts him in quiet moments.

Despite his cynicism, Chris's unwavering love for his younger brother Eric and steadfast loyalty to his wife Jo reveal a man still driven by deep connections, even as he battles inner demons, lost dreams, and a growing fear that life's harsh realities have eroded his once hopeful spirit.

ERIC WALKER

Eric, a career Air Force CH-47 Chinook pilot, has three years in the classified UFO retrieval program, his faith in the system slowly eroding. Once an idealist, he now wrestles with secrecy, duty, and morality, recording everything in a meticulous journal - a coded log of retrieval missions, classified craft, base locations, and hidden truths the world isn't ready for. Knowing exposure means death, he hides the journal for Chris to find, ensuring the truth doesn't die with him.

His tragic arc fuels Chris's transformation, forcing his once-skeptical brother to finish what Eric started - unraveling a conspiracy that threatens not just their lives, but the fate of humanity itself, as powerful forces close in from all sides.





GABRIELLA "GABI" MENDEZ

Gabriella "Gabi" Mendez is a sharp-witted Air Force CH-47 Chinook pilot in the UFO retrieval program, excelling under pressure with tactical precision. Hard-nosed and disciplined, she thrives in high-stakes environments, but beneath her armor lies a guarded heart shaped by a lifelong bond with Eric—a fellow pilot she grew up with and has always trusted above all others.

TAWODI "OLD HAWK" KANATI

Tawodi "Old Hawk" Kanati is a proud and serene Cherokee elder whose ancient mysticism grants him uncanny intuition and a deep connection to unseen realms. His knowledge of the UFO phenomenon isn't just folklore - it's lived experience, intertwined with spiritual wisdom passed down for generations.

ALAN HOLT


Alan Holt is the resolute CEO of Skycraft Aerospace, a private aerospace contractor serving as a front for a hidden faction resisting Dr. Weller and the Mirror Men. A former Air Force engineer turned industrial powerbroker, Holt's ambition is matched only by his strategic foresight. His demeanor—cool, calculated, and unsentimental—conceals his deep-seated commitment to exposing the truth behind nonhuman technology and government cover-ups.

In The Mirror Men, Holt emerges as a critical player in the underground resistance, leveraging advanced technology and insider knowledge to challenge Weller's shadow government and push for global Disclosure. His leadership is marked by precision and quiet authority, steering Skycraft toward the singular goal of revealing what has long been hidden.



Psionics (Creative Thought Energy) refers to psychic abilities—telepathy, telekinesis, precognition, and mind control—that allow individuals to influence the physical world with the mind alone. In The Mirror Men, psionics is treated as a covert science developed through real Cold War-era CIA programs like MKULTRA and STARGATE. These black ops experiments laid the groundwork for "Black Reality," a secret initiative led by Dr. Harrison Weller.

By merging advanced mental training with alien technology, Weller creates the Mirror Men—operatives capable of extracting memories, distorting perception, and glimpsing potential futures with a melding of psionic precognition and alien tech. The series explores how thought can be weaponized, truth distorted, and free will undermined—blurring the line between speculative fiction and terrifying plausibility.





DR. HARRISON WELLER

A ghost in the corridors of power, Dr. Harrison Weller is a former Cold War-era CIA operative turned architect of global manipulation. Recruited into the ultra-classified BLACK REALITY program in 1969, Weller was trained in psionics—remote viewing, telekinesis, telepathy, precognition and psychic warfare—at the height of U.S. paranoia over Soviet mind-tech advancements. But by the 1990s, disillusioned and ambitious, Weller splintered off to form his own covert faction: the Mirror Men.

Now the invisible hand behind the intelligence community, Weller uses advanced, nonhuman-tech eyeglasses linked to his psionic abilities to glimpse future timelines, bending events before they unfold. Calm, clinical, and unsettlingly precise, Weller is less a man than a weaponized consciousness - one who has obstructed Disclosure and First Contact for decades and is the custodian of civilization's illusion of order.

MIRROR MEN

The Mirror Men are not mere black-budget operatives - they are the unseen architects of control, forged in the CIA's BLACK REALITY program, a Cold War-era psyops initiative designed to manipulate perception and suppress emerging threats. Originally trained in psychological warfare, they evolved into something far more insidious, infiltrating the highest levels of intelligence. More than assassins, they are custodians of knowledge capable of collapsing governments, rewriting physics, and shifting global dominance. With psionic abilities - telepathy, time distortion, remote viewing and telekinesis - they are near-unstoppable.

Bound by a brotherhood dating back decades, they answer to no nation, only their own hidden agenda. But as Chris, Gabi and Old Hawk disrupt their grip, their dominion faces its first true challenge.





DIRECTOR HELENA VOSS

The cunning intermediary between the U.S. intelligence community and a rogue faction, Voss is the linchpin keeping both sides in check. To the government, she is the calculating head of UFO retrieval and reverse-engineering efforts. In truth, she serves the hidden faction led by Dr. Weller and his Mirror Men, ensuring alien technology remains under their control.

A master manipulator, she eliminates threats with cold precision, convinced secrecy is the only safeguard against global chaos. Her ties to defense contractors and black-budget projects grant her near-limitless reach.

As the war for control escalates, Voss walks a perilous line - playing both sides in a game where even she may be expendable.

LT. COLTON TRASK

A former colleague of Eric's in the UFO retrieval program, Trask is a calculating and ambitious antagonist driven by greed and personal gain. Ruthlessly loyal to those in power, he profits from the cover-up, exploiting secrets for his own advancement.

His charm masks a dangerous, cunning individual, making him an unpredictable and formidable adversary. Trask's betrayal of Eric fuels his relentless pursuit of control, placing him in direct conflict with those seeking truth, as he stops at nothing to protect his interests and silence those who threaten them. Privately, Trask lives an opulent lifestyle, indulging in luxury, status, and fleeting relationships.




DR. ROHAN KAPOOR

Dr. Rohan Kapoor is a brilliant physicist specializing in recovered alien technology. A Princeton graduate, he once believed secrecy was necessary, but he's uncovered a disturbing truth - a rogue faction has been stealing breakthroughs in anti-gravity, advanced weaponry, and psionics, operating beyond U.S. intelligence and Congressional oversight.

Long loyal to Director Voss, he now realizes he's been deceived. Kapoor isn't an idealist, but he knows when he's been used and discarded. Now, he faces a choice: stay silent and remain complicit or risk everything to expose the truth. For the first time, Kapoor isn't just chasing knowledge - he's questioning who controls it and why.





PILOT SYNOPSIS PT 1

In the haunting expanse of the Mojave Desert, a covert military operation "captures" a UFO under the direction of mysterious "Mirror Men" - individuals with unnerving telekinetic abilities and unnaturally cold thermal signatures, aside from their hot skulls.

Captain Eric Walker, a military helicopter pilot, secretly records the classified mission, hiding the evidence inside his journal and a USB disguised as a uniform clasp. Partnered with fellow pilot Gabi Mendez, Eric plans to expose the government's decades-long UFO cover-up by meeting with investigative journalist Logan Marshall.

When Eric's superiors discover his betrayal, he's forced to flee. In a desperate moment, he hides his journal in his brother Chris's toolbox before escaping. Pursued by Lieutenant Trask and the Mirror Men, Eric's vehicle plunges off the road into a canyon. Though his body isn't recovered, the Mirror Men extract his memories through a painful form of telepathy.


Meanwhile, in a classified facility hidden within a mountain, Director Helena Voss and Dr. Harrison Weller are developing "TeleSight." Glasses using alien tech that could predict and potentially alter future events. Dr. Weller believes that Disclosure of alien existence would trigger societal collapse and must be prevented at all costs. This is Dr. Weller's plan to prevent Disclosure from happening, and consequently, First Contact.

PILOTSYNOPSIS PT 2

When Chris learns of his brother's disappearance, he discovers Eric's journal in his toolbox. Gabi arrives and reveals the truth about the government conspiracy. Together, they find the hidden USB containing irrefutable evidence of the Mirror Men's psionic nature and the capture of an extraterrestrial craft. Their discovery is interrupted when the Mirror Men track them to Chris's home.

As the Mirror Men telekinetically attack, an elderly neighbor named Old Hawk intervenes using ancient Native American spiritual practices to temporarily disrupt their abilities. Despite his help, the Mirror Men kill Chris's wife, Jo, during the assault. Chris, Gabi, and Old Hawk narrowly escape with Eric's evidence.

Now fugitives with crucial proof of the government's nonhuman reverse-engineering technologies program, Chris and his unlikely allies face a desperate mission: rescue Jo, find Eric if he's still alive, and decide whether to expose the truth that Dr. Weller and his Mirror Men have protected for decades. Their choices could trigger the societal upheaval that Weller fears or finally bring humanity into an enlightened age beyond secrets and lies.





When his brother Eric—an Air Force pilot in a secret UFO retrieval program—vanishes, blue-collar worker Chris Walker is thrust into a covert war over nonhuman technology. Joined by Gabi and Native elder Old Hawk, Chris uncovers Eric's encrypted journal and flees from psionic assassins—only to lose his wife Jo to the Mirror Men.

DAY 2

After escaping, Chris, Gabi, and Old Hawk take refuge in Carlsbad Caverns—a childhood sanctuary for the Walker brothers. Deep inside, Chris deciphers Eric's journal, uncovering links to Alan Holt, CEO of Skycraft Aerospace. Flashbacks reveal a young Eric's first brush with the unexplainable. Meanwhile, Voss turns Eric over to Kapoor for TeleSight experiments, as Trask closes in, triggering a desperate escape through the caverns.

Chris, Gabi, and Old Hawk follow Eric's journal to Skycraft Aerospace, uncovering its ties to black-budget military projects. Kapoor warns Voss about the tech's side effects, but she insists Eric be the first test subject. Meanwhile, Old Hawk begins training Chris in Native mysticism to resist the Mirror Men's psionics. Logan's investigation draws dangerous attention. Elsewhere, Weller is at the ancient Pyramid, where he demonstrates the Apex Chamber's power to rapidly enhance psionic abilities.

DAY 4

Episode 4 dives into a flashback revealing Dr. Harrison Weller's recruitment into the CIA's secret BLACK REALITY program during the Cold War. Trained in psionics—remote viewing, telekinesis, and telepathy—Weller becomes a powerful operative. Disillusioned by agency limits, he breaks away to form the Mirror Men, a covert faction able to manipulate perception and silence threats. Through calculated infiltration, Weller seizes control of key intelligence networks, laying the groundwork for decades of covert influence and buried truths.

On the run, Chris, Gabi, and Old Hawk connect with journalist Logan Marshall, who sheds light on Eric's mission and the conspiracy at large. Their reunion is cut short when the Mirror Men attack, triggering a narrow escape. Meanwhile, Skycraft CEO Alan Holt emerges as the leader of a covert resistance against Weller and the Mirror Men, armed with alien tech. At Voss's facility, Kapoor begins psychological tests on Eric using the TeleSight glasses. Guided by Old Hawk, Chris begins unlocking Native American mysticism within himself.

DAY 6

Extraterrestrials are revealed not just as visitors but allies opposing the Mirror Men—beings who support Disclosure and secretly aid Holt's resistance. Chris, Gabi, and Old Hawk meet Alan Holt, who shares his alliance with these nonhuman allies and his mission to stop Weller. Old Hawk reveals his past as a U.S. Army codebreaker tasked with deciphering alien symbols—his first encounter with the Mirror Men. Meanwhile, Kapoor bonds with Eric and secretly sabotages the TeleSight glasses, as Trask and the Mirror Men close in.

Logan is assassinated by the Mirror Men, sparking unrest among underground believers. Dr. Weller accelerates his psionic development in the Apex Chamber, while Kapoor's failed effort to help Eric escape forces him into hiding. Voss locates Holt's underground base and orders Trask to launch an assault. Armed with Kapoor's secrets, Eric prepares for a second escape attempt. Meanwhile, Chris, Gabi, and Old Hawk join Holt in activating a frequency disruptor—designed to weaken the Mirror Men—for a daring rescue mission.

DAY 8

In a daring assault led by Gabi, Chris, Old Hawk, and Holt's rebels infiltrate the hidden facility to rescue Eric. The mission falters—Trask is killed, but Eric remains captive. Weller uses the TeleSight glasses to manipulate future events, halting Disclosure, but he's blinded in the process by Kapoor's doing. Meanwhile, Eric, now tapping into his new psionic abilities from the TeleSight glasses, telepathically contacts Chris and reveals the approximate location of the ancient Pacific pyramid. A shocking twist reveals Weller's new alliance with a reptilian alien species.

SPINOFF

Set between the 1970s and 1990s, The Mirror Men: Black Reality follows CIA recruit Dr. Harrison Weller, drawn into BLACK REALITY—a secret U.S. program weaponizing psionics through real-life Cold War experiments like MKULTRA and STARGATE.

As the U.S.–Soviet race to reverse-engineer alien technology unfolds, the UFO cover-up takes root.

Weller quickly masters psionics—telepathy, telekinesis, precognition—but uncovers a deeper truth: the government is hiding alien breakthroughs that could upend civilization. Fearing Disclosure, yet tempted by its power, Weller recruits fellow operatives to form the Mirror Men.

By the late 1980s, this rogue faction operates deep within U.S. intelligence—using psionics and alien tech to manipulate events, suppress Disclosure, and reshape global power from the shadows.
