### **Reflection**

*Today, the whole Catholic Christian Church celebrates the Solemnity of Christ the King of the Universe. The Gospel this Sunday is taken from John 18:33-37 and it is part of the passion narrative, where Jesus was interrogated by Pilate. The issue here is the kingship of Jesus. The Lord Jesus redefines his kingship in terms of the “unworldly” kingdom. He underlines the complete otherness of his kingship and even makes the particular point that must have been decisive for the Roman judge. No bloodshed and no one is fighting for his kingdom.*

*Jesus didn't say that his kingdom is not “in” this world, but that it is not “of” this world. His interest wasn't the title “King” as a designation for someone who controls an earthly kingdom that has armies, warships, fighter planes, and nuclear missiles to defend and promote its powers, but in the fact that he is the agent of God, the one sent by the Father, to bear witness to the truth. When Pilate asks him, “What have you done?”, the listener knows that Jesus' whole life and ministry have been a revelation of, and witness to, the truth, a revelation of the Father and of his grace, his faithful loving kindness and truth.*
