1ST SUNDAY OF ADVENT (YEAR B) 3RD DECEMBER 2023

### **Watchfulness**

Our gospel this 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Advent comes from St. Mark 13:33-37. The emphasis of the parable is the readiness of the servants to open the door to the master at his return. Opening the door to an exhausted traveler and being ready to tend to his needs was a very important service to the master whether he was exhausted after the heat of the day, after a journey lasting into the midnight hour, or throughout the night to the early hours, maybe even until dawn or later. St. Mark mentions these four 'watches' into which the Roman day was divided. The doorkeeper didn't know in which watch the master would return. Unbroken vigilance was therefore required if he was to be properly attended to on his arrival.

Jesus finally addresses his original audience of Peter, James, John and Andrew and tells them to 'watch' and not only they themselves are to watch, but all of us are to watch. This universal command ties this parable, to the warnings of the coming of the Son of Man who is already at the door. But a more imminent 'hour' is about to break upon the sleeping disciples, who failed to keep watch in spite of the repeated warnings to 'watch and pray'.
