Intercessions after the Homily

All: Lord, hear our prayer.

Reader: For all who are carers. May they share the Lord's healing strength, and receive his energy and patience to continue the Lord's good works. May they always learn from the people they serve. We pray to the Lord.

All: Lord, hear our prayer.

Reader: For all whose hearts are heavy this day with grief or loneliness. May they be filled with greater faith in others, hope in their Church and comfort and support in their daily lives. We pray to the Lord.

All: Lord, hear our prayer.

Reader: For all who have died in the Lord. May they be welcomed by Mary and the Saints into the presence of God. May they enjoy peaceful communion with the Angels, the Saints, and all our deceased family, friends and parishioners. We pray to the Lord.

All: Lord, hear our prayer.

Reader: In these prayers of intercession, let us pause in silence to remember any other people or situations that we wish to commend to the Lord. *(pause)*

Reader: We invoke the help of Our Lady's prayers, for she is Our Lady of Sorrows and the Comforter of the Afflicted. And so, we say her prayer together. HAIL MARY...

Priest: Let us pray.

O God, you are our refuge and our strength, You are the source of all goodness. Listen kindly to the prayers of this faithful gathering, and grant that your people may fully receive your blessings and mercy this day. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.
