## **Reflection**

*The Gospel this Sunday is from Mark 9:30-37 and the message is how to be great in the Christian community.*

*Jesus' message was clear. "Whoever wants to be first must be last of all and servant of all" (Mk 9:35). He backs up his word with a prophetic gesture; the presentation of a little child and says; "Anyone who welcomes one of these children in my name, welcomes me" (Mk 9:37). "Welcome" means loving service to the weaker members of the community, those who stand in greatest need of being served.*

*The evangelist St. Mark has made the point that the revelation of Jesus can't be acknowledged by one who is not ready to enter into the spirit of discipleship and thereby become "last" and "servant". One would hope that the being Christian nowadays is attuned to the bold message of this word of Jesus: greatness in his Church is found in SERVICE, and only there. It is a demand that leadership in the Church, at every level, be Service, not in word but in deed.*
