CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY (YEAR C) 22ND JUNE 2025

Reflection

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi or the Body and Blood of Christ. It is the celebration of the Sacrament of the Eucharist where we partake of the Body of Jesus as nourishment for our spiritual life. We refer the Eucharist as "Thanksgiving". For what was Jesus giving thanks during the Lord's Supper? That his prayer was heard (Hebrew 5:7). He gave thanks in advance that the Father did not abandon him in death (Psalm 16:10). He gave thanks for the gift of the Resurrection and on that basis, he could already give his body and blood in the form of bread and wine as a pledge of resurrection and eternal life (John 6:53-58).

In the Eucharist/Mass, we the body of Christ, both receives the gift of Jesus Christ and gives grateful thanks to God for such a blessing. This thanksgiving is the only proper response, for through this gift of himself in the celebration of the Eucharist under the appearances of bread and wine Christ gives us our food for the journey and gift of eternal life.



Canonisation of Bl. Carlo Acutis – Pope Leo XIV held the first Ordinary Public Consistory of his pontificate, with Cardinals giving their formal approval for the canonisations of eight Blessed. During the ceremony, the Holy Father announced that Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati and Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonized together on 7th September 2025.
