Reflection

The readings for the 8th Sunday in Ordinary time Year C, invite us to reflect on the integrity of our hearts, emphasizing that words we speak and the fruits of our actions reveal our true selves. They challenge us to examine what fills our hearts as it shapes our character, influences our speech, and directs how we live out our faith.

The images of the good and the bad trees illustrate how the fruit that we produce in life reflects what is at the core of our being. Because figs and grapes don't come from thorns and shrubs, we should take a careful look at our lives to see what kind of fruits we are bearing. The mouth speaks words that come from the treasure that lies in our hearts. The words and the deeds that we express indicate the spiritual condition of our lives.
