Reflection

The Gospel in this 7th Sunday Ordinary time Year C, is taken from Lk. 6:27-38. Jesus' preaching to love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, pray for those who mistreat you, give generously to those who ask of you, and lend without expecting anything in return greatly exceed human expectations. The standards Jesus set are remarkably high, going far beyond the more accepted standards of doing for others what we would want done for us.

The prayer, the good deeds, the blessings, the forgiveness, and the generosity that Jesus urges upon his followers are all forms of Christian love. This merciful love is a response to the generosity, the blessings, and the forgiveness God has bestowed upon us. We can only love in this supernatural way because God has extended his grace upon us in such incredible abundance.

When we refuse to judge and condemn others, but rather forgive and show generosity, our own lives will be characterized by that kind of abundance. God is like a seller measuring grain in the marketplace. He fills the container, presses it down, gives it a good shake, then heaps the grain to overflowing while emptying the grain into the lap of the buyer. In this way, God pours abundance into our lives in an absolutely full and overflowing measure of graces.
