## 3<sup>RD</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (YEAR C) 26<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2025

## Reflection

The readings for the 3rd Sunday ordinary time year C, emphasize the transformative power of God's Word in uniting His people, bring them joy, and sending them forth on mission. As we reflect on those readings, we are reminded of the centrality of Scripture in our lives and its power to shape us as a community of faith.

Today's Gospel shows Jesus proclaiming the Word of God in the synagogue at Nazareth. From the scroll of prophet Isaiah, he selected the passage that contained the Messianic vision of preaching, healing and liberation (Isaiah 61:1-2). Then he declared that this marvelous prophecy was being fulfilled among them.

Jesus was sent, not to the wealthy or the powerful, but to the poor (the least, the lost and the last), the oppressed and the suffering. Who are the poor? In the first place, the poor are those who live on bread alone and who never hear the Word of God. But the poor are also the dispossessed of this world, those who are waiting for liberation. The good news must not be limited to spiritual blessings only.
