All Saints Day

In all the festivals we celebrate, including those of the saints, God Almighty is the only object of worship and our praises. When we honour and praise the saints, we worship God who bestows His graces upon them. The saints of God portray to us the way to love God and live unto Him. With all their weaknesses they were able to honour and praise God Almighty through their lives. They demonstrate to us that it is feasible in this sinful and wretched world to remain faithful to His calling.

Today's celebration is focused on all the saints of Heaven, but especially on those we could call the little people of Heaven: those obscure, uncanonized, unbeatified, uncelebrated and anonymous saints whose name will never figure in a liturgical calendar. The kind people who did nothing to become famous, but who knew how to love; who accepted to die day by day to their natural selfishness, and who, through the ordinary tasks of ordinary life, lived with extraordinary beauty. Today is their feast.

The Saints, they who have lived out the Beatitudes, are the only truly happy people of this world. Even while suffering, they can say like St. Paul: "I am overjoyed in the midst of persecution (2Cor. 7:4). Because, for Christian, suffering is not incompatible with joy, since it is lived out "for the sake" of Jesus, and since it becomes the opportunity for a greater and resemblance to the Beloved.

A reading from the second book of Revelation

7:2-4, 9-14

And I heard the number of the sealed, one hundred and forty-four thousand, sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel.

SECOND READING

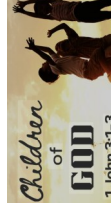
A reading from the first letter of
