The readings for the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A, invite us to reflect deeply on the theme of light, unity and discipleship. At the heart of today's liturgy is a strong and comforting message: God brings light where there is darkness, unity where there is division and hope where there is despair.

In today's 1st reading from the prophet Isaiah 8:23-9:3, we hear the promise of light coming into darkness. Prophet Isaiah speaks to a people who have experienced pain and despair, yet he assures them that a light will shine upon those who dwell in the shadow of death. This prophesy is fulfilled in Jesus Christ, who comes to bring hope and redemption.

In the 2nd reading from the letter of Paul to the Corinthians 1:1-3, 13-14, emphasizes the importance of unity within the Church. He urges us to set aside divisions and to be united in mind and judgment. Division can cloud our mission, but Christ calls us to be one, reflecting the same light prophet Isaiah foretold. In a fragmented world, our unity serves as a powerful witness to the presence of Christ among us.

In the Gospel taken from Matthew 4:12-23, we see the beginnings of Jesus' public ministry. After John the Baptist's imprisonment, Jesus begins to preach the good news of the kingdom of God, calling fishmen, ordinary people to follow Him and become "fishers of men". As we reflect on these readings, let us ask ourselves; how do I respond to Christ's call in my life? How can I bring light into the darkness I encounter in my family and community? Am I fostering unity or am I allowing division to separate from each other and from God?
