“Constant Alertness”

In order to instruct his disciples on his future coming, Jesus again tells a parable. As in many of his previous teachings, the parable illustrates an aspect of the kingdom and begins with words, “The kingdom of heaven will be like this.” Through the parables, Jesus both surprises and disturbs his listeners, opposing their presuppositions and moving them to new understandings. In order to unfold the mystery of the kingdom, which will be established in its fullness when the Son of Man comes in glory, the parable presents the coming Lord as the bridegroom. Similarly, the prophets had presented God as the bridegroom of Israel and expressed the covenant bond between God and his people through the imagery of marital love (Is 62:5; Jer. 2:2).

Jesus’ conclusion to the parable emphasizes its lesson: Constant alertness is necessary because it is impossible to pinpoint the time of the Lord’s coming. The parable is a warning to the Church, which consists of both wise and foolish disciples. The gospel of St. Matthew highlights this parable because, the return of Jesus has indeed be on delayed. Jesus has not returned as swiftly as many in the early Church anticipated. The Church must learn to remain vigilant, anticipating the Lord’s coming while its members persevere in faithful service and proclaim the kingdom to the nations.
