# **Sunday Reflection**

Our readings today are about discipleship. They focus on the dynamics, the dignity and the drama of being a follower of Christ.

The first reading from the Old Testament book of Samuel describes God calling young Samuel in the middle of the night. In the Gospel, Jesus calls Andrew and it is Andrew who brings Peter to Jesus for the first time. Here we see something of the dynamics of discipleship that still continue today.

When, then, Jesus responds to the disciples with the phrase "Come and See", the invitation is operating on two levels and programmatic. The disciples are being invited to come and see where he lives in his present dwelling, a simple booth perhaps or shelter along the banks of the Jordan. On the deeper level they are being invited to embark upon a life of discipleship that will involve "seeing" where he truly lives: "ever in the bosom of the Father" (Jn. 1:18)

The dynamics of discipleship is to go on the journey that will enable them to make their own affirmation: "we have seen glory, as of an only Son of the Father, full of grace and truth" (Jn. 1:14).
