### Reflection

The Gospel this Sunday is taken from Luke 24:35-48. This passage underlines with the greatest emphasis the physical reality of the risen Christ. This multitude of signs provided by Christ to the Eleven disciples is easily understandable: the apostles must witness before the whole world to the resurrection of Christ. That is why to them he presented himself alive after his passion and death, by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days. For indeed, the certainty which is at the basis of their mission must rest on irrefutable proofs.

Jesus then commissions his disciples for the decisive role they are to play in the new and final phase of salvation history: they are to be witnesses to Jesus Christ, proclaiming repentance and forgiveness, beginning in Jerusalem and extending to the whole world.

Risen Lord, send your Holy Spirit upon me so that I may be filled with joy and empowered to be your witness. Help me to recognize you as you make your presence known in word, sacrament and the lives of your disciples today.
