### **Sunday Reflection**

The Gospel this 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Lent is taken from Mark 9:2-10. The "Transfiguration" narrative. On this occasion of Jesus transfiguration, he enables his disciples momentarily catch sight of his divinity. Why? So that, when during Passion he will lose even the appearance of a human being (the prophet Isaiah says that, 2he was inhumanly disfigured that he no longer looked like a man" Is. 52:14), the disciples might look beyond the appearance of the disfigured Jesus and remember that transfigured Jesus of today's event. In other words, Jesus wanted to fortify his disciples in advance, he wanted to strengthen their faith in him in preparation for the impending great temptation their faith will undergo when they witness his passion and death.

On this mount of Transfiguration, Jesus felt comforted and affirmed. He knew that the Father was pleased with him, and would give him the strength to face the ordeal ahead. With God on his side, he could face anything. So too, with us, as St. Paul says: "With od on our side who can be against us?" In our dark moments, we must do what Jesus did. We must seek the transfigured God in prayer.
