Sunday Reflection

Today's Gospel shows that Jesus' teaching made a deep impression on his listeners because, unlike the scribes (the official teachers), he taught them with authority. He commanded the unclean spirit and it obeyed him. These miracles signified in action what he preached in words. Jesus' powerful words, are accompanied by his equally powerful deeds. The people speak of his act of exorcism as "a new teaching".

Why did Jesus make an impact to his listeners? It is because his teaching originates from immediate contact (moment of prayer) with the Father, from face-to-face dialogue – from the vision of the one who rests close to the Father's heart.

I suppose this gospel is an invitation for us to reflect on this Year of Prayer which Pope Francis announced last Sunday (21st January 2024) during his Angelus to establish a moment of prayer to the Lord Jesus who has the authority to liberate us from the bond of the unclean spirit.
