### **Abide in Love**

This section of the gospel of John 15:1-8 is the centerpiece of the entire sequence at the Last Supper and features what is possibly the best known and best-loved text from the entire address: Jesus' description of himself as the "True Vine". In the sentences that follow, aspects of this image are unfolded in the interest of the disciples' "remaining" of "abiding in love".

When Jesus describes himself here as "the true vine" there is an implied contrast with Israel as the unfruitful vine, while he himself is the nucleus of a renewed Israel which will yield the "fruits" that God, the owner of the vineyard, seeks.

"Apart or cut off from me you can do nothing" (15:5), as Jesus can do nothing without the Father. The Father expects the disciples, his children, to bear fruit. He is glorified-revealed-in the Son, in his obedience and in the perfect accomplishment of his work. The glorification-revelation-of the Father also in the obedience and fruitfulness of those who are joined to the Son. The Father's activity and that of the disciples come together in the production of fruit, with Jesus as the 'vine' and the 'place' where growth and fruit are achieved.

As the Risen Christ has lived and conducted his mission by remaining/abiding continually within the divine love, so we his disciples should remain/abide within the extension of the divine love that we have experienced and will continue to experience from Jesus.
