# **Sunday Reflection**

The Gospel reading of this 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Lent gives us a picture of Jesus' cleaning actions of the Temple. The fundamental purpose behind the cleaning of the Temple is to remove whatever obstacles there may be to the common recognition and worship of God and thereby to open up a space for common worship. (Pope Benedict XVI, Jesus of Nazareth: Holy Week, p.18)

Jesus wants to return to original purpose of the Temple, which is, a place of covenant renewal and reconciliation between God and his people. So, in making the Temple a marketplace is a defilement of the sacredness of the place.

Jesus cleaning action is an anticipatory sign of what will come into effect at the culminating Passover in which he will give his life for the life of the world. His crucifixion is at the same time the destruction of the old Temple. At his Resurrection, his risen body is the new Temple. Therefore, a new way of worshipping God begins, no longer on this or that mountain, but "in spirit and truth." (Jn.4:23).

Lent is a time of cleaning/purifying our body which is, the Temple of God (1Corinthians 6:19), not just to hope for things, to go away, but as Jesus does, to remove, to expel in a serious and radical way all the infidelities, sins and distortions of our life.
