## **Sunday Reflection**

The readings in 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time Year B talks about sickness and sufferings. Job in the 1<sup>st</sup> reading lament. He says, "My pain is more than I can bear. I can't sleep at night, I shall not see happiness again." Job's lament is a cry we all feel within ourselves when we become seriously ill or when someone we love becomes ill or dies.

In this world full of sufferings and pains Jesus comes. The Gospel reading today, the Lord heals Simon's mother-in-law and then people with all sorts of illnesses. Jesus didn't view sufferings as a punishment from God. It is part of human conditions. For Jesus, suffering is an opportunity to show what God is like. He reveals the compassion of God in face of human suffering.

Suffering is an unavoidable element of the human condition. The road of suffering is a narrow and dark one. But it's a great comfort to us to know that Jesus went down this road and went down it to the end. It is not the same since he travelled it. A bright light illuminates it.
