Reflection

The Gospel is taken from the section in Matthew where Jesus denounces the Scribes and the Pharisees. [The Scribes were a class of professional exponents and teachers of the Torah (law). They were held in respect and were addressed as "my lord" or "master" (rabbi). The Pharisees (Hebrew "perusim", the "separated" ones) were the party who adhered to the strict interpretation of the Law.]

Most theologians believe that the speech reflects not just the deep opposition between Jesus and the teachers of the Law in his time, but also the conflict between the followers of Jesus and the Pharisaic Judaism. Jesus recognizes the leadership of the scribes and the Pharisees and tells his disciples and the crowds to observe everything they teach. But they should not follow their examples. And Jesus, strongly recommends his disciples to practice humility, not arrogance. True greatness pertains to service, not privilege. A servant does not lay heavy burdens on the shoulders of others, but bears their burdens. A servant does not seek attention, because a servant's attention is on the needs of others. A servant is not concerned about prestige, for a servant claims no titles. A servant simply serves, and within the community of disciples that is true greatness.

So, by selling their produce here in their behalf, this will prevent the Christians from leaving the country in search of better work opportunities, as a test survey from the bishops of Jerusalem there is only forty-one thousand Christians left in the area.
