“Divine Mercy Sunday”

The Gospel narrative of this Sunday is taken from John 20:19-31. In this chapter 20 of the gospel of John, we noticed accounts of appearances of the risen Jesus that becomes a series of encounters illustrating different faith reactions. The first reaction is that of the Beloved disciple who believed when he saw the garments left in the tomb; second reaction; Mary Magdalene believed when she heard the voice of risen Jesus and realized that it was the Lord; third reaction; Thomas believed when challenged by the risen Jesus to carry out a disbelieving program of probing.

The final praise for belief, however, is extended by Jesus to those who have believed without seeing garments of bodily presence. The author of the Gospel portrays no greater praise can be given to Jesus than “My Lord and my God”, no greater praise can be given to Jesus’ followers than “Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.”
