Transfiguration

The Gospel this Sunday is taken from Luke 9:28-36. The evangelist Luke continually emphasizes that prayer is the context for understanding who Jesus is and what it means to be his disciple. He shows Jesus at prayer when he asks His disciples, "Who do you say I am?" Eight days later Jesus takes His disciples up the mountain to pray and he is at prayer when His disciples witness his transfigured glory. St. Luke demonstrates that deepening faith in Jesus is a result of a prayerful contemplation of his life.

Prayer is not only about entering into a relationship with God; it is also about being changed or transfigured. Healthy prayer strengthens our bond with the Creator and it also transforms us. Every encounter with God provides the opportunity for us to grow spiritually. Prayer makes a difference in our life because it gently pushes and persuades us to develop Christ-like qualities in our attitude and actions. Through prayer we become more loving, gracious, compassionate, and justice-oriented human beings. When this happens, we are altered in a positive way and the world we touch is also transformed for the better.



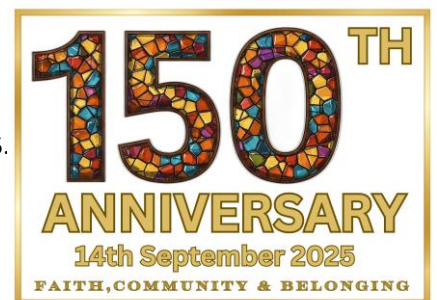
