6TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (YEAR C) 16TH FEBRUARY 2025

Reflection

The Gospel in this 6th Sunday Ordinary time Year C, is taken from Luke 6:17, 20-26 "The Beatitudes". First of all, beatitudes are situated within a long tradition of Old Testaments such as in our first reading from prophet Jeremiah 17:7-8: "Blessed is the person who trusts in the Lord." These are words of promise. At the same time, they are criteria for the discernment of spirits and so they prove to be directions for finding the right path.

When the Lord says "Blessed" are you poor, hungry and so forth, He is not saying to those who are burdened by life that their life is ideal, far from it. The Lord is teaching that there is a truth within their circumstances, a strength they don't realize. Within the tragedy of their lives is a hidden grace. And when the Lord says, "Woe to you who are rich, popular, healthy", He is saying that there is a hidden danger in their lives.

Jesus knows that we his disciples will be persecuted and rejected for our faith in him. Yet, it is our association and trust with him in the present that unlocks the hidden graces.
