**PENTECOST SUNDAY (YEAR C) 8<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2025**

## **Reflection**

The word Pentecost indicates that the feast is celebrated on the fiftieth (50<sup>th</sup>) day after the Passover. For us Christians it's the feast of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit to the apostles when they were praying in the upper room together with Mary the Mother of Jesus. The beginning of the new covenant on earth. It's the birth of the Church, in its journey to the meeting with the Lord, receives constantly from Him the Spirit which gathers it in faith and charity, sanctifies it, and sends it on its mission.

St. Luke the author of the Acts of the Apostles talks of the Holy Spirit as the Re-creator. The new creation inaugurated at Pentecost, when the curse of Babel (Genesis 11:1-9) is reversed. Through the power of the Spirit of God the fragmentation of peoples that occurred at Babel is reversed and the human race is being reunited. In the second reading St. Paul told the Romans that the Spirit with which you received during baptism will enable them to call God "Abba", Father. Abba is a term tender and personal used by adults as well as children. And the gospel which is taken from John 14:15-16, 23-26 speaks about "Parakletos" and assures us that the Holy Spirit is the Paraclete, the one who stands alongside of us to help us when we ourselves are helpless.

### SECOND READING

**Romans**  
**A reading from the letter to the Romans**

**8:8-17**  
Brothers and Sisters: Those who are in the flesh cannot please God. You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit; if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.

So then, brothers and sisters, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, 'Abba! Father!' The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs — heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.


