Reflection

The readings for the 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C, invites us to reflect on the profound mystery of God's call, the response it demands from us, and his empowering grace that sends us forth to serve.

Peter's feeling of unworthiness at receiving God's bounty and in the presence of God's authority leads him to fall down at the knees of Jesus. Peter's humble perception of himself as a sinner before the Lord shows his insightful understanding of the greatness of Jesus and humanity's condition. At first Peter thinks that his sin means that he can have nothing to do with Jesus. But Jesus shows how the realization that one is a sinner is fundamental to discipleship and spiritual growth. He takes the faith and the humble attitude of Peter and transforms them into a call to serve.
