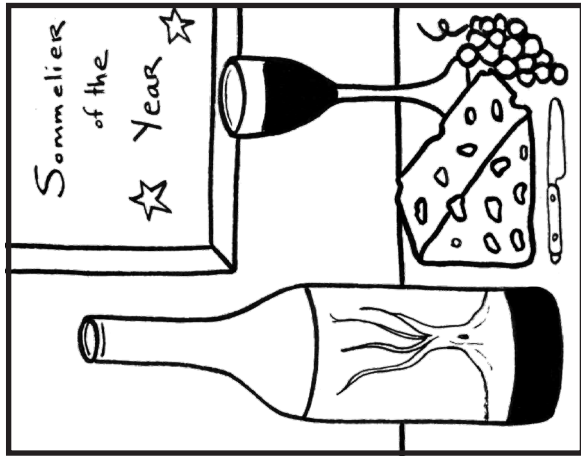
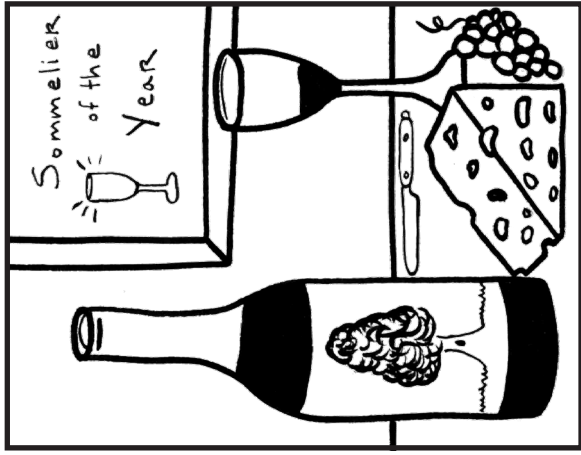
## Did You Know?

McMinnville, Oregon is home to more than 250 wineries, making it a great place for those who are interested in wine making! Our sommelier is a North Island brown kiwi, one of five different species of flightless birds native to New Zealand. Kiwis have a great sense of smell, making them perfectly suited to this job.

Sommeliers are professionals who often work at wineries or restaurants and are knowledgeable about all things related to wine, including helping customers to know the best wines to pair with different foods. It can take up to 20 years to complete the certifications and the Master Sommelier Test (considered to be one of the hardest tests in the world). In the past 40 years, only a small portion of the thousands who tried have passed.
