


What If...Wombats Were Web Developers?

Wombats can weigh up to 85 pounds at full size and be up to 3 feet in length. They are surprisingly fast runners, clocking speeds of up to 25 miles per hour. They also have fur that glows in the dark under a UV light. Scientists are still trying to figure out why.
