- Education: Provide access to education and help with school expenses
- Employment: Promote employment and selfemployment opportunities
- Rehabilitation: Provide financial help for rehabilitation and arrange marriages for the blind
- Awareness: Raise awareness about the abilities and issues of blind and visually impaired people
- Health: Promote health rights for people with disabilities
- · Quality of life: Improve the quality of life for blind
- Accessibility: Create accessible environments for blind people
- Affordable products and services: Provide affordable products and services to enhance the quality of life for blind people
- Community involvement: Encourage community involvement to create a network of support

HISTORY

We have supported and helped 400 people to date including 200 children and 200 young and old people. We helped them with healthcare, accommodation and education facilities. We provided them with nutritious food.

Story

Yash, a native of Haryana's Karnal District, registered in a nearby school but was unable to attend due to his health. The teachers at Yash's school paid no attention to her attendance. They even admitted that they had had no instruction on how to instruct kids who have vision impairments. Yash was delighted to meet JAX Foundation volunteers and soon noticed a complete turnaroundaround in his life. Yash received regular therapy and was also subjected to a skill-development training program where they would use a Braille slate, an abacus, a Taylor Frame, and many other technologybased teaching aids for the blind.

OBJECTIVE

- Improving sanitation: Work on projects to improve sanitation conditions in slum areas, such as community toilets, waste management, and hygiene awareness.
- Providing access to basic amenities: Work to improve access to basic amenities like water supply, sanitation, and electricity.
- Providing education: Work to improve access to quality education for children and adults through schools and vocational training centers.
- Providing healthcare: Work to improve access to affordable and accessible healthcare services through clinics and community health centers.
- Providing livelihood opportunities: Work to create sustainable livelihood opportunities through entrepreneurship development, skills training, and access to microfinance.
- Raising awareness: Raise awareness about the rights and needs of slum dwellers
- Empowering women: JAX can help women improve their socio-economic status through self-help groups, training programs, and income-generating activities.

HISTORY

We have helped 1500 people in 12 slums in delhi. We took care of their health by giving them checkups and medicines. Provided primary and higher studies education. 
