#### Story.

Yash, a native of Haryana's Karnal District, registered in a nearby school but was unable to attend due to his health. The teachers at Yash's school paid no attention to her attendance. They even admitted that they had had no instruction on how to instruct kids who have vision impairments. Yash was delighted to meet JAX Foundation volunteers and soon noticed a complete turnaround in his life. Yash received regular therapy and was also subjected to a skill-development training program where they would use a Braille slate, an abacus, a Taylor Frame, and many other technology-based teaching aids for the blind.
