- **Treasurer Pay** Motion by Wegand to approve an increase of \$1400 for treasurer, effective February 1, 2024, motion carried.

# New Business

• Election Workers Wage— The board reviewed several other municipalities wages. Wegand made a motion to approve \$12 per election worker and \$15 per chief, seconded by Flick, 2 ayes, 0 nays, Coenen abstained. Motion carried.

### Reports of Officer's, Boards, Committees

- Treasurers Report Balances were reviewed, paperwork was signed by all for the CD's. Taxes went well. Bank drop off is down.
- Review & Pay Bills Motion by Flick to approve the bills of \$1,138,970.55, seconded by Coenen, 3 ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Chairman is still working with the County on the agreement for the landfill.
