

In August, Gillespie County saw a significant development when Judge Pattillo of the 216th District Court denied a motion to dismiss the injunction hearing involving AMPYR Energy USA, the developer of the Marshall Springs Solar/BESS project.

Looking ahead, the next hearing on this issue is set for 9:00 am September 29-30 at the Happy State Bank Expo Center at 3875 Hwy-27 in Kerrville. Our County Commissioners and County Judge Daniel Jones have encouraged us that a strong citizen turnout will ensure that everyone present understands the urgent health, safety, and environmental concerns surrounding this project.

Due to damages incurred from summer flooding, the Kerr Co. Courthouse is unavailable to the courts, staff, and public. So alternative settings for court hearings have been established, and sometimes they are subject to change on short notice. We will post an update if the location is moved between now and then. Getting there at least 30-45 minutes early is recommended.
