Privacy Policy

College Settlement of Philadelphia places a high priority on protecting your privacy. This privacy policy explains what types of information are collected by our website, how that information is used, and the measures we take to protect it.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect or have access to information that personally identifies you ("Personally Identifiable Information" or "PII") only if you choose to share such information with us. We also collect certain information automatically as you navigate the site.

Information You Voluntarily Provide:

- Contact Information: Name, email address, mailing address, and telephone number when you sign up for newsletters, fill out a contact form, register for an event, or make a donation.
- Donation Information: Payment information (credit card numbers, bank account information), which is processed securely by third-party payment processors. We do not typically retain full credit card numbers once processed.
- Communications: Records of your correspondence with us, such as emails or inquiries submitted via forms.

Information Collected Automatically:

- Log Data: Our servers automatically record information that your browser sends
 whenever you visit our website. This data may include your Internet Protocol (IP)
 address, browser type and settings, the date and time of your visit, and how you
 used the site.
- Cookies and Tracking Technologies: We use "cookies" (small text files placed on your device) and similar technologies to help provide better services, analyze trends, track user movement on the website, and gather demographic information. You can choose to disable cookies through your individual browser options.

2. How We Use Information

We use the collected information for internal purposes only, such as:

- Providing you with services or information you request.
- Processing donations and issuing receipts.
- Sending you e-communications, promotional materials, or advertisements that may be of interest to you (you may opt-out at any time).
- Improving our website and the services we provide.
- Generating and analyzing statistics about website usage (using de-identified information where possible).
- Detecting, preventing, and responding to fraud or other misuse of the website.

3. Sharing of Information

We may share your information with trusted third-party service providers (e.g., payment processors, email marketing platforms, event management services) to help us operate efficiently. We ensure all third parties comply with relevant data protection standards.

We will not sell, rent, trade, or transfer your personal information to outside organizations for their own use without your consent. We may disclose information if required to do so by law.

4. Data Security and Retention

We take appropriate measures to safeguard your personal data from unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction using security measures like encryption and secure servers. However, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure.

We retain your personal information only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected or as required by applicable laws.

5. Your Rights and Choices

You have rights regarding the personal information we maintain about you. These may include the right to:

- Request access to and receive information about the personal data we hold about you.
- Update or correct inaccuracies in your personal information.
- Request that we limit or stop processing your data, or have it blocked or deleted, as appropriate.
- Opt-out of receiving future communications.
