Thank you for your interest in the Summer Camps at College Settlement's programs!

The 4 basic steps to register for Camp are...

- 1. Fill out the Camp Scholarship Application (optional)
- 2. Complete the Online Camper Registration
- 3. Pay the Registration Deposit
- 4. Gather and Upload ALL Necessary Paperwork

Camper Registrations and scholarship applications can be completed online at <u>www.collegesettlement.org</u>. Before completing the online registration, however, please read the **Parent & Guardian Handbook**. The Handbook contains important information regarding our programs, policies, and typical daily schedules.

Your child's space is not secured until you've completed these steps! More information is located below.

OR

1. Fill out the Camp Scholarship Application (Optional)

Our pricing has been updated! To ensure transparency and fairness, we've changed our pricing structure and financial assistance process. While our updated prices reflect necessary adjustments, we remain deeply committed to offering robust financial assistance to families in need. **Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis**.

Option 1: Pay Full Price for Camp

- Day Camp (2-week session): \$900
- Overnight Camp (2-week session): \$1350
- Teen Adventure (2-week session): \$1500

Option 2: Apply for a Camp Scholarship

Completing the camp scholarship application will provide a discount code, based on your financial situation, that you can enter during registration. This process ensures that our limited scholarship funds are directed to families who need them most.

2. Complete the Online Camper Registration

After determining your discount using the scholarship application, you can complete your camper registration via our <u>online portal</u> and enter your discount code. Please note that registration for **ALL** sessions closes on May 30th. Your registration **MUST** be completed and submitted by this time – we are no longer registering throughout the summer.

3. Pay the Registration Deposit

As of 2025, the Registration Deposit has increased to \$75.00 per child, per session. This amount is part of your total balance and is not an additional fee.

4. Upload the Necessary Paperwork

The following documents must be submitted **4 weeks before** the first day of your child's session start date:

Camper Medical Form

This form is completed by your child's pediatrician and must be received by the Camp Office at least 4 weeks prior to your child's session start date. WE MUST HAVE A PHYSICAL EXAM ON FILE THAT HAS BEEN COMPLETED WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF YOUR CHILD'S SESSION START DATE. For example, if your child had a physical completed in June of 2024, it will likely be expired before their first day of Camp. We are required to have recent physicals on file for all campers, so please schedule an exam as soon as possible.

Immunization Records

You must submit your child's immunization records, along with the Camper Medical Form, at least 4 weeks prior to your child's session start date. We require all campers to be fully vaccinated. Covid vaccinations are highly recommended, but not required – all other vaccinations remain mandatory. There are no exceptions or exemptions. Your child's registration will be cancelled if we do not receive their Medical Form and immunization records in time.

Uploading Your Paperwork

Your child's Medical Form and immunization records must be uploaded to the online registration portal or emailed to <u>upload@collegesettlement.org</u> four weeks before your child's earliest session start date. All final payments are also due at that time. If we do not receive your paperwork and final payments in time, your child's Registration will be cancelled and their spot will be given to a Waitlisted camper.
