



GROOM & FAMILY

GROOM

- Wears a traditional black suit

FAMILY

- Mother of the Groom wears a traditional Hanbok in Blue, Grey, or Green
- Mother of the Bride traditionally wears a Pink, Purple, or Orange Hanbok
- Others often wear black suits as well



WEDDING

BEFORE

- The Jeonanrye ceremony
- Family of the Couple and the groom greet guest as they come in
- The bride is in the waiting room where guest can go in and take photos
 - She is normally seated because of how big the dress is
- Presentation of the

CEREMONY

- Begins with the entrances of the Mother-In-Laws
- Followed by the groom
- Proceeded by the Bride with either her father or the oldest man within her family who gives him to the Groom
- The master of ceremony/priest then begins the ceremony
- Most modern weddings follow a christian ceremony where "opening prayer, declaration of intent, vows, exchange of rings, unity ceremony (optional), blessing, pronouncement, and closing remark" (Wedding Forward)



WEDDING

CEREMONY CONTINUED

- After the ceremony the couple and the guest will exchange bows-similar to the Gyobaerye and Seong-hon-rye



RECEPTION

- Receptions are mostly short and sweet with some western traditions added in
 - First dance, throwing the bouquet, dancing, and entertainment
- This will also be when the food is served
