

The Do's and Don'ts of UNBELIEF in something

Psalms 4:3

But know that the ADON hath set apart him that is holy for himself: the ADON will hear when I call unto him.

Ephesians 5:7-8

Be not ye therefore partakers with them. For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Adon: walk as children of light.

- **Do not** wish people greetings or reply: "same to you" if you do not believe in what they are celebrating. It is hypocritical to do that.

-**Do** state your truth in meekness, whether it offends the person or not. Your witnessing will edify the person.

2 John 1:10-11, *If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed: For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds.*

- **Do not** receive anything from anyone that has anything to do with idolatry (pagan festivals, fake holy days...) or sin in general unless there is an absolute need, which can only be perceived through the discretion of the Ruach Ha'Qodesh.

Proverbs 15:27, *He that is greedy of gain troubleth his own house; but he that hateth gifts shall live.*

Romans 1:32, *Who knowing the judgment of Elohim, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.*

Acts 15:28-29, *For it seemed good to the Ruach Ha'Qodesh, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things; That ye **abstain from meats offered to idols**, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well.*

- **Do not** take part in revelry nor activities pertaining to paganism. Do not attend any gatherings or events that are against Elohim's word, neither attend any events that have any similar characteristics to these pagan gatherings. Refer to this verse below in 2

Thessalonians 3:6.

Psalms 1:1, *Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.*

Hebrews 13:9 *Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein.*

- **Do not** engage in foolish conversations about things you do not believe in, nor joke about the things that you do believe in, it is a sin. **Ecclesiastes 5:6**, *Suffer not thy mouth to cause thy flesh to sin; neither say thou before the angel, that it was an error: wherefore should Elohim be angry at thy voice, and destroy the work of thine hands?*

-**Do** Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man; **Colossians 4:6**.

Psalms 39:1, *I said, I will take heed to my ways, that I sin not with my tongue: I will keep my mouth with a bridle, while the wicked is before me.*

- **Do not** allow sinners, nor your 'brethren' to pull you into sinful activities, conversations, nor to pagan events, no matter what they want to tell you. If anything, admonish them and avoid these people entirely. Refer to **Deuteronomy 13:6-9** & **2 John 1:10-11**.

Proverbs 1:10, 15, *My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not.*

My son, walk not thou in the way with them; refrain thy foot from their path.

2 Thessalonians 3:6 (AMP version) *Now we charge you, brethren, in the name and on the authority of our Adon Yahusha Ha'Mashiach (the Messiah) that you withdraw and keep away from every brother (fellow believer) who is slack in the performance of duty and is disorderly, living as a shirker and **not walking in accord with the traditions** and instructions that you have received from us.*

Jeremiah 10:8 *But they are altogether brutish and foolish: the **stock** is a doctrine of **vanities**.*

2 Corinthians 6:16-17, *And what agreement hath the temple of Elohim with idols? for ye are the temple of the living Elohim; as Elohim hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their Elohim, and they shall be my people. Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Adon, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.*
