

Smoking Fentanyl? Let's Go Over What We Know!

- For the first time, the CDC reported that more people are dying from smoking drugs than injecting them.
- Illicitly manufactured fentanyl accounted for the vast majority of deaths






Who is most at risk?

- Stimulant users who are opioid naive
- Black Americans, who now account for the fastest growing demographic for illicitly manufactured fentanyl deaths.

Safer Smoking: A Few Simple Steps

- Researchers in Philadelphia and San Francisco have documented numerous accidental
 fentanyl overdoses that occurred after an opioid naive individual used another person's
 smoking equipment that contained residue from prior fentanyl use.
- Pipes used to smoke fentanyl should be kept for personal use only. Residue left behind when passed to the next person could trigger an overdose.
- Single use foil squares are available from some harm reduction groups for "chasing the dragon" but some fentanyl users feel this method risks wasting some of the drug.



We recommend buying an oil burner (bubble/meth pipe). Wrap a piece of electrical tape around the mouthpiece to identify it as a fentanyl pipe. And don't share it! The shape of the pipe will enable you to better regulate your intake and waste less drug material.

Best of all, you might even save a life!
