

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Reported Effects

- Blackouts
- Decreased heart rates
- Decreased blood pressure
- Severe disorientation
- Effects persisted after stopping use
- At least 2 people sought treatment in ER after ingesting

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


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Two different light blue pills one with the imprint “A|51” and the other with the imprint “ALG” over “265” were sold in Philadelphia, PA as oxycodone 30mg but actually contain the potent tranquilizers xylazine and medetomidine, as well as methamphetamine, and cocaine. The samples were submitted from Philadelphia, PA, where at least two people sought treatment in the ER after ingesting them.

The pills, **pictured at right**, were obtained by PA Groundhogs (PAG) on Nov. 20 in Philadelphia County via our partner lab, The Center for Forensic Science, Research & Education (CFSRE), for analysis.



This is the first time that PAG has tested a pill submitted as an opioid and found it to have no opioid present.
