

TOURNAMENT RULES

GAME PLAY

- DIVISIONS ARE GRADE BASED
- Game Clock will be a <u>STOP CLOCK</u>
 - 1st 3th Grade: 12 minute halves
 - 4th Varsity: 14 minute halves
 - Halftime: 2 minutes or as time permits
- Running Clock if team is leading by 20 pts or until lead is cut to 12 pts to return to stop clock
- Overtime will be a 3 minute running clock with last minute stop clock
 - 1 timeout issued during 1st overtime (timeouts do no carry over to Double or Third Overtime)
 - Double overtime will be a 1 minute running clock
 - Third overtime will be sudden death (1st team to score)
- 2 Full Timeouts Per Half (No regulation timeouts carry over to overtime)
- 2 Free Throws given when a team enters the <u>DOUBLE BONUS on the 7th team foul</u> (No 1 & 1)
- Game time is forfeit (site director may grant an extension up to 10 minutes based on situation)
- Rules and Guidelines are in accordance with High School Federation Rules
- Player Safety will be followed by all staff, officials and participants
 - Officiating team may stop live play to protect a player
 - Only athletic apparel and/or protective equipment will be worn during game
 - NO EARRINGS, WATCHES, RINGS BRACELETS, SMART DEVICES OR MONITORS

COACHES' RESPONSIBILITIES

- Challenging A Players Grade Eligibility, must take place <u>NO LATER THAN 15 MINUTES</u> <u>AFTER COMPLETION OF GAME</u>.
 - A \$75 fee per player challenged must be paid to initiate a challenge. If a challenge is won, the fee is returned or if a challenge is lost, the fee will be credited to the team's future events with FCA.
- Coaches must be able to provide proof of a player's grade eligibility by providing both a:
 - Report card, progress report, class schedule, current school ID or a student/parent school portal.
 - A birth certificate or State ID as proof to ensure a player meets age requirement in division.
- All Games Will Be Vacated/Forfeited that the player participated in if a coach is unable to provide proof of a player's grade and age, or it is determined the player is not eligible.
- **Players Can Not Be Added** to participate in just the last game of a tournament. Players must have played in any of the first 2 games of the tournament to be eligible to play in the last game.

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

- If any of the following occurs, individuals will be subject to removal for a game or the day
 - Heckling of officials by coaches, players, parents and all other spectators
 - Fighting by anyone including, officials, coaches, players and spectators
 - Threatening acts or gestures by anyone
- Full Court Athletics reserves the right to take any or all of the following actions
 - Removal from the event & future events
 - Forfeiture of a game
 - Law Enforcement involvement
- ALL DECISIONS FROM TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR ARE FINAL

GRADE BASED ELIGIBILITY

All Divisions Are Grade Based

Players <u>MUST BE IN THE GRADE LEVEL IN WHICH THEY ARE COMPETING</u>. Any boy player is allowed to play up in any division, but is not allowed to play down in a division. <u>A PLAYERS' GRADE LEVEL IS THE PRIMARY FACTOR OF A PLAYERS' ELIGIBILITY</u>.

The age cut-off date below is utilized to cap an age limit within each division or allow younger players who have accelerated in school due to academic achievements.

1st/2nd Grade – a player must be <u>in the 2nd grade as of Sep 1, 2023</u> & must <u>be 9 years old or younger</u> <u>on Aug 31, 2024</u>. Or a player in the 3rd grade that is 8 years old or younger on Jun 30, 2024

3rd Grade – a player must be <u>in the 3rd grade as of Sep 1, 2023</u> & must <u>be 10 years old or younger on</u> <u>Aug 31, 2024</u>. Or a player in the 4th grade that is 9 years old or younger on Jun 30, 2024

4th Grade – a player must be <u>in the 4th grade as of Sep 1, 2023</u> & must <u>be 11 years old or younger on</u> <u>Aug 31, 2024</u>. Or a player in the 5th grade that is 10 years old or younger on Jun 30, 2024

5th Grade – a player must be <u>in the 5th grade as of Sep 1, 2023</u> & must <u>be 12 years old or younger on</u> <u>Aug 31, 2024</u>. Or a player in the 6th grade that is 11 years old or younger on Jun 30, 2024

6th Grade – a player must be <u>in the 6th grade as of Sep 1, 2023</u> & must <u>be 13 years old or younger on</u> <u>Aug 31, 2024</u>. Or a player in the 7th grade that is 12 years old or younger on June 30, 2024

7th Grade – a player must be <u>in the 7th grade as of Sep 1, 2023</u> & must <u>be 14 years old or younger on</u> Aug 31, 2024. Or a player in the 8th grade that is 13 years old or younger on Jun 30, 2024

8th Grade – a player must be <u>in the 8th grade as of Sep 1, 2023</u> & must <u>be 15 years old or younger on</u> Aug 31, 2024. Or a player in the 9th grade that is 14 years old or younger on Jun 30, 2024

9th Grade – a player must be <u>in the 9th grade as of Sep 1, 2023</u> & must <u>be 16 years old or younger on</u> <u>Aug 31, 2024</u>. Or a player in the 10th grade that is 15 years old or younger on Jun 31, 2024

Junior Varsity – a player must be in the 11th grade or lower as of Sep 1, 2023 & must be 17 years old or younger on Aug 31, 2024.

Varsity – All player must have been <u>enrolled in a high school or lower grade as of Sep 1, 2023</u> & must <u>be 19 years old or younger on Aug 31, 2024</u>

NOTE: GIRLS ARE ALLOWED TO PLAY ONE GRADE BELOW THEIR CURRENT GRADE IN ANY BOYS DIVISION.
