

SAFETY INSTUCTION & REGULATIONS

1. Operator and passengers must wear personal floatation devices at all times.
2. Driver should always attach the engine stop switch to their life vest so that the engine stops if the driver falls off.
3. If you fall off the craft, try to fall away from craft on your back.
4. Never operate the watercraft while or after consuming alcohol or taking drugs. Operating under the influence is a federal offense and is subject to fines as high as \$5,000.
5. Sailboats, commercial vessels and boats have the right of way.
6. Always be aware of traffic around you.
7. Watch for low water and or wake zones.
8. Absolutely NO beaching the watercraft.
9. You must stay at least 300 ft from all other motorized watercraft.
10. Be aware of changing weather conditions. If conditions change on the water and you feel unstable, return to the cove with your watercraft.
11. Stay away from designated swim area and other hazards marked. Watch out for swimmers and divers.
12. Wake jumping is very dangerous and prohibited.
13. Do not put hands, feet or clothing near the jet intake on the bottom of the Jet-ski while the engine is running.
14. If you fall off, board from the rear of the Jet-ski. Use the rear grab handle to pull your knees to the platform. Then pull yourself forward using the handlebar to maintain balance. Passengers should climb in the same way after the drive is on board. Reconnect safety switch and restart engine.
15. Do NOT become AIRBORNE.
16. No chasing, harassing or disturbing the wildlife.
