

SAFETY INSTUCTION & REGULATIONS

1. Renter must be a good swimmer, in good health and physical condition to particaipate in this activity.
2. Operator and passengers must wear personal floatation devices at all times.
3. Driver should always attach the engine stop switch to their life vest so that the engine stops if the driver falls off.
4. If you fall off the craft, try to fall away from craft on your back.
5. Never operate the watercraft while or after consuming alcohol or taking drugs. Operating under the influence is a federal offense and is subject to fines as high as \$5,000.
6. Sailboats, commercial vessels and boats have the right of way.
7. Always be aware of traffic around you.
8. Watch for low water and or wake zones.
9. Absolutely NO beaching the watercraft.
10. You must stay at least 300 ft from all other motorized watercraft.
11. Be aware of changing weather conditions. If conditions change on the water and you feel unstable, return to the cove with your watercraft.
12. Stay away from designated swim area and other hazards marked. Watch out for swimmers and divers.
13. Wake jumping is very dangerous and prohibited.
14. Do not put hands, feet or clothing near the jet intake on the bottom of the Jet-ski while the engine is running.
15. If you fall off, board from the rear of the Jet-ski. Use the rear grab handle to pull your knees to the platform. Then pull yourself forward using the handlebar to maintain balance. Passengers should climb in the same way after the drive is on board. Reconnect safety switch and restart engine.
16. Do NOT become AIRBORNE.
17. No chasing, harassing or disturbing the wildlife.
18. Speeding in no-wake zone or areas marked is restricted.
19. No towing other vessels.
20. No pets allowed on craft.
21. No smoking while on craft.

Jetski is NOT to be operated between sunset and sunrise. Operating during these hours is AGAINST THE LAW. This means when you have your ski for an over-night, this does NOT exempt this rule.

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
