

District 7 IHSRA Scholarship Program

Every year District 7 High School Rodeo gives out scholarships to hard working students and athletes competing in our District. The purpose of the District 7 Scholarship Program is to provide students with a scholarship to aid them in their pursuit of higher education. Scholarships are awarded during the Awards Ceremony at the end of the season.

- Must be a member of NHSRA and competing in District 7
- Must provide verification of acceptance to school or completion of a semester before scholarship funds are disbursed
- Must be a graduating high school senior and plan to attend an accredited college, university, technical school or trade school in the United States. (Funds can be held if student is planning a gap year or service opportunity before enrolling in college)
- **An editable Application Form can be found on the IHSRA website under the scholarship tab**
- Application and statement must be **TYPED** and not handwritten
- A signed statement must be typed and in your own words, including your education aims, career plans, goals and objectives in life, not to exceed 150 words. Make sure you sign your application on pages 7 and 8.
- Include an Official High School Transcript with Accumulative GPA. The transcript must have the **School's Official Stamp and Dated**. The transcript does not need to be in a sealed envelope. The transcript should show all (4) four years of high school.
- Include a completed and signed **High School Rodeo Director/Advisor's Recommendation**. Recommendation must be in a sealed envelope and submitted with the application
- Submit Scholarship Application in a **CLEAR FOLDER**
- **Scholarships are scored based on GPA, Rodeo Participation, and Achievement**
