A GUIDE TO PURCHASING



Purchasing an animal may seem to be an intimidating investment but it is an easy and cost effective way of purchasing locally raised, high quality meat. When you buy a 4-H project, you purchase all your cuts of meat - steaks/chops, roasts, ribs, hamburger - for the same price and support youth & local agriculture!

Animals will be sold via live auction at the Agriplex and Online through DLMS based on weights verified at the North Thompson Agriplex immediately prior to the Expo.

Slaughter, cutting, and wrapping may occur at your choice of Rainer Custom Cutting or Rangeland Meats. For these options, transportation is covered and arranged by the BC Ag Expo Committee. If you would like your animal transported elsewhere, self haul is also an option with approval. If you purchase a carcass animal, it is already hanging at Rainer Custom Cutting and will be cut and wrapped based on your instructions.

Lamb is available for pickup from your selected cutting facility 7-14 days after the auction, while beef is available 4-5 weeks after the auction. Cutting and wrapping must be paid to your selected facility prior to or when you pick up - check with your abattoir once your order is ready.

AVG. Live Price: 1400lbs x \$4.50 = \$6300 AVG. Cutting & Wrapping = \$1050 \$7350 for 505lbs Freezer Ready Beef ~ \$14.50/lb

CHEVON (goat)

AVG. Live Price: \$300
AVG. Cutting & Wrapping = \$100
\$350 for 30lbs Freezer Ready Chevon
~ \$15/lb

LAMB

AVG. Live Price: \$650

AVG. Cutting & Wrapping = \$110

\$760 for 50lbs Freezer Ready Lamb

~ \$15.20/lb



RAILGRADE

If you do not need beef, lamb, or chevon in your freezer, you can take advantage of our railgrade options where steers, lambs, and chevon are resold at current market prices by the pound. (Carcass animals are not eligible). These arrangements are made through the Sale Office at the Curling Rink and you will receive payment 6-8 weeks after the sale.

FILL OUT CUTTING FORM

If you decide to keep the meat for yourself, outline which facility you would like your animal sent to and contact the facility to fill out cutting form with instructions regarding what cuts of meat you would like.

SIGNATURE c\ PAYMENT

Sign off and make your purchase official. Payment can be made by cash, cheque, e-transfer, or credit card. (Credit card option will be billed with a set processing fee).
