### **ENTRIES:**

1. Entry deadline is June 30. No refunds of entries after deadline. All Leaders must enclose an address and contact name and phone number with entries – please specify your Club name.
2. Age of participants:
  - a. 4-H Junior - 9 to 11 years as of Dec 31<sup>st</sup> of previous year
  - b. 4-H Intermediate - 12 to 14 years as of Dec 31<sup>st</sup> of previous year
  - c. 4-H Senior - 15 to 19 years as of Dec 31<sup>st</sup> of previous year
  - d. Open Youth - 6 to 9 years at the time of the fair (ex. Cloverbuds)
3. 4-H project entry fee for the BC Agricultural Expo includes:
  - a. Gardening Judging
  - b. Gardening Showmanship
  - c. Unit Work (must register using the 4-H unit currently enrolled in)
4. Please bring the following items for presentation in the designated area:
  - a. 4-H Gardening Record Book (or scrapbook of progress for Open Youth)
  - b. Gardening display board including photographs and captions describing the work completed in their specific Gardening unit. Maximum display board size dimensions are: Height 120cm, Depth 120cm and length 180cm. Related props are allowed. No food or produce.
