LAMB CARCASS RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. One Entry per exhibitor and the class is open to both wethers and ewes.
- 2. All 4-H entries must be tagged as a 4-H project.
- 3. 4-H Entries accompanied by \$80, plus GST, must be received by June 30th. Open Entries accompanied by \$100, plus GST, must be received by July 15th. Open Post entries may be accepted at the BC Ag Expo on a case-by-case basis. Post entry fee is \$25.00 (non-taxable), plus the regular entry fees and applicable taxes.
- 4. Six percent (6%) on the amount of the sale of each carcass sold will be retained by the BC Agricultural Exposition Society to assist in meeting general expenses.
- 5. All livestock manifests for transporting to and from the fair should include the North Thompson Fall Fair Premise # BC4469RH3
- 6. All carcass lambs must be in the barn by 5:00 PM on the Thursday of the Expo, but an earlier weigh in would enable lambs to be shipped to the slaughterhouse earlier.
- 7. All entries must include a live photo of the lamb for DLMS and display purposes.
- 8. Lambs to be shorn just prior to attending BC Ag Expo.
- 9. All entries will be slaughtered as arranged for by the BC Ag Expo Committee.
- 10. Each carcass will be appraised by officers of the Livestock Division for points allocated for carcass quality.
- 11. ALL CARCASSES MUST BE SOLD THROUGH SALE
- 12. All entrants in this division are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the BC Ag Expo, as well as the 4-H & OPEN Sheep Rules & Regulations.
- 13. The top 2 placed carcasses in each class, 4-H & Open, only, will return to the Expo for display. Prize money will be awarded to top four carcasses in each Division during the Saturday Evening of the Expo.
- 14. All Carcass Lambs will be stalled together until shipment to the Processing Plant
