General Rules and Regulations

- 1. One entry per exhibitor. 4-H entries must be tagged as a 4-H project. CCIA tags will be used as ID tags. All projects must be tagged and registered under a CCIA tag.
- 2. Animals entered in this class shall not be more than 22 months of age.
- 3. All entries must be delivered to RAINER CUSTOM CUTTING in DARFIELD BC. Date and Time to be announced Approx. 2 weeks prior to the fair. This will allow for a proper slaughter and hanging time of the carcass for a fair evaluation.
 - (WEIGHING Facilities unavailable at Rainer's therefore 4-H entries must organize their own weighing to get live weight for their record book).
- 4. All entries shown in this class are to be slaughtered as arranged for by the BC Ag Expo and carcasses scored by an officer of the carcass committee according to current standards for quality grade, yield grade, and carcass weight requirements.
- 5. Only dehorned cattle will be eligible maximum 2" and under from base of head to tip of horn
- 4-H entry deadline June 30th. Open entry deadline July 15th. Fees must accompany entries. All carcass entries are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the BC Ag Expo.
- 7. The Grand and Reserve Champion 4-H and Open Division carcasses will return to the Expo for display and will be eligible for prize money. Carcass Awards will be handed out during Saturday Night events.

- 8. In the event that one of the Division champion carcasses does not Grade A the committee reserves the right to display the next highest A grade carcass from the other Division.
- Please upload a quality photo of yourself with your live carcass steer late in the feeding period to your online entries or to secretary@bcagexpo.ca. This photo will be used for display purposes and for the online Sale website with DLMS.ca

Carcass Auction Rules

- 1. All Carcasses must be sold through the action on the Monday of the Expo at a 6% commission to British Columbia Agricultural Exposition Society.
- 2. Carcasses will be sold on the basis of price per lb of carcass weight. The auctioneer will give the highest bidder the option to take just one or both sides.
- 3. Carcass animals will be sold throughout the sale in order of placing.
