TWEMLOW FAMILY EVENT REGULATIONS

1. Neither the British Columbia Agricultural Exposition Society, nor the North Thompson Fall Fair Grounds in Barriere will be responsible for any accidents connected with this contest.
2. This event will be held on the Friday evening of the BC Agricultural Expo.
3. Club members who have won a money for a lamb in this 4-H event previously, are not eligible.
4. Qualifications for contestants are:
 - a. Age limits – 11 by January 1st and not reaching 20 by December 31st of the current year.
 - b. Be a member of a 4-H Club competing at the current year's BC Agricultural Expo.
 - c. 4-H boys & girls interested in the feeding and caring of the lamb.
 - d. Must be able to feed and care for a lamb and have the necessary facilities and feed for proper care, feeding and training of lamb.
 - e. Must comply with all terms as stated in the "Entry Form" and must provide the BC Ag Expo Committee with the Liability Release form.
 - f. Must have completed a full year in club work in the sheep division previous to this current year.**
 - g. Must be a member of a 4-H Lamb Club this year.
 - h. Must be a member of a regularly organized 4-H Lamb Club, competing at the BC Agricultural Expo the following year.
 - i. The Lamb will be eligible for the "Twemlow Family Event" and **MUST** be used as the 4-H member's market project and subject to regular husbandry checks by the member's club leader.
 - j. The lamb is subject to all BC Ag Expo General and 4-H/Open Sheep Rules and Regulations
 - k. The prize shall be used to purchase a 4-H project lamb for the following year, to be shown at that year's BC Ag Expo.
5. Failure to comply with any of the above prescribed regulations will result in forfeiture of the lamb, its return and ownership will revert fully to the BC Ag Expo Twemlow Family Event Committee.

Twemlow Family Event Regulations cont.

6. If the lamb has a problem and has to be sold, or dies, and the BC Ag Expo Twemlow Family Event Committee wishes to replace said lamb, the lamb must be replaced before July 1st to still be eligible for the Twemlow Family Event.
7. Monies from the sale or insurance must be forwarded to the BC Ag Expo Fair Twemlow Family Event Committee, to aid in replacement of said lamb. If the lamb dies after July 1st, it is no longer eligible for replacement for this event at BC Ag Expo.
8. The BC Ag Expo Event Committee reserves the right, without prior notification, to set up separate classes for boys and girls and to make any other change in regulations that, from time to time, are deemed necessary by the BC Ag Expo Twemlow Family Event Committee.
9. \$15 Non-refundable entry fee made out to the British Columbia Agricultural Exposition Society must accompany each entry.
10. BE ADVISED: As part of the competition, a proper working rope halter is required to be constructed. The committee chairs advise all entrants to learn how to make a rope halter prior to the event on the Saturday evening of the fair, in order to assist them with their success in the competition.
