### BC Ag Expo Ambassador Program

#### Rules and Regulations

##### **Purpose:**

To promote leadership in youth at the BC Ag Expo by providing a program where senior members and young adults can formally mentor junior members and give back to their community. The program is intended to provide benefits to the Fair, Ambassadors, and the junior members they mentor. It is the BC Ag Expo's hope that this initiative will encourage the senior members and young adults to become more involved in the implementation of BC Ag Expo and the 4-H program in subsequent years.

##### **Requirements of BC Ag Expo Ambassadors:**

1. Must be 16 – 25 years of age.
2. Must commit to attending at least part of BC Ag Expo as well as one committee meeting. They may attend the committee meeting virtually.
3. Must conduct themselves in a professional manner that positively portrays youth and the BC Ag Expo at all times.
4. Agree to wear Ambassador apparel when appropriate at BC Ag Expo.
5. Must submit an application prior to **August 1<sup>st</sup>** of the calendar year.

##### **Requirements of the BC Ag Expo:**

1. The designated Committee Member will oversee the program.
2. Each division representative must be open to working with the ambassador assigned to them and provide them with direction before and during the Fair.
3. Provide letters of reference for the ambassadors as appropriate.
4. Provide official ambassador clothing.
5. Offer a bursary program only for individuals that commit to the ambassador program.

### **Bursary**

The President, Vice President and committee members overseeing the program will collaborate after the BC Ag Expo, no later than December 1, to determine the recipients of the two \$500.00 bursaries available. If any committee members feel they are in conflict, they will remove themselves from decision making.
